DAY 01: ARRIVAL IN BANGKOK, THAILAND

NOVEMBER 11, 2023

DAY 02 : TEMPLES & KLONGS TOUR

(B, L)

After breakfast, group will be picked up and taken on a Full Day Tour. Go behind the scenes for a closer look at Buddhist culture. Start the morning with a trip to Wat Pho, arguably Bangkok's most enchanting temple. Arrive just as the resident monks gather for their morning chants. Witness this deeply spiritual ritual and gain a better sense of Thailand's Buddhist heritage. Continue to the nearby Grand Palace, which has served as the seat of Thailand's revered Royal family for more than two centuries. Take a walk around the vast grounds, stopping in to explore the various temples, throne halls and museums within the compound. Visit the Emerald Buddha, the most revered Buddhist image in Thailand, and hear about its mysterious origins. Lunch included at riverside restaurant. Then continue onwards to visit Wat Trimitr, on the edge of Chinatown, which houses the world's largest solid gold Buddha. Then take a long-tail boat. Move away from the high rises of the city and venture through the quiet canals upon which the city was originally built. Catch glimpses of the olden days, passing by charming neighbourhoods built on the water's edge. Return to the main waterway, the Chao Phraya River, to visit Wat Arun. Meaning 'Temple of the Dawn', this riverside pagoda dates to the 17th century. Following this insightful exploration of Bangkok, return to the hotel. Evening is on own at leisure

NOVEMBER 12, 2023

DAY 03 : EVENING TWILIGHT TOUR

After breakfast, group will have the day at leisure to further explore on their own. This evening group will be picked up and will be taken with private guide on a Twilight Street Food Delights By Tuk Tuk. Before the night crawls in, be met by the guide at the hotel and take a trip together on a public transport to the meeting point nearby Hua Lamphong Railways Station. Be briefed for this fun evening for the start, and then it's time to hop on this Bangkok's iconic 3-wheel, Tuk Tuk, for a night adventure ride to visit the best local eateries around the famous street zone in town. Bangkok is claimed to be the city that never stops eating. Bangkokians usually find themselves eating out at night, especially street food, which the city is also well-known for. Be taken for a ride and make various stops at local places in which even smells will definitely delight your taste buds. From the local favourite Northern Thai-Isan Food, the best kept-secret Guay Tiew Gai guaranteed with a Michelin star for 2 consecutive years, and one of the best Pad Thai in town popular popular for both locals and foreigners alike, all bites are then truly pleasing!

Between the bites, make some nice stomach breaks at the city's old town landmarks. Visit Wat Pho, the famous iconic sight of Bangkok for a nighttime perspective, and here, be wowed by its illuminated chedis while learning all about the history of the temple. Also, walk through the city's largest flower market, Pak Klong Talad, which is busy 24-hours a day with wholesale vendors and local shoppers. Explore the stalls where orchids, flowers, vegetables and other items spill over the crowded stalls. Here,

there is a chance to taste some local snacks or fruits. The night ends with a final stop outside a secret, hidden bar located by the river. Sip a chilled Thai beer or a non-alcoholic drink while enjoy an amazing night view of the Chao Phraya River along with the glittering Temple of Dawn. After the tour finishes, be dropped off at the hotel by tuk tuk. Tour ends approx. 10:00 pm

NOVEMBER 13, 2023 DAY 04 : FLOATING MARKET

After breakfast, group will be picked up and taken to Damnoen Saduak Floating Market. Visit Damnoen Saduak Floating Market in Ratchaburi Province about 100 km from Bangkok. Take a longtail boat ride through the canals and see how Thai people live alongside the labyrinth of canals in this area. Arrive at the famous Damnoen Saduak market where you can stroll around the colourful floating marketplace bustling with boats and vendors selling tropical fruits and other delights. Afterwards, proceed to the Sampran Riverside to enjoy a Thai buffet lunch before heading back to Bangkok. The rest of your day is on own at leisure.
