

2022 GLDC YEAR-END HIGH PERCENTAGE AWARD

Award Classifications:

Junior - A person who is 21 years old or younger within the award year.

Amateur – A person, 22 years old and older, who engages in Dressage for the pleasure of it rather than for money.

An amateur may not accept payment (remuneration) in any form such as cash, goods, discounts or services, or in-kind exchange of goods or services such as boarding or training. An amateur may not take remuneration for riding, exercising, showing, training, assisting in training, schooling or conducting clinics or seminars aside from incurred expenses.

Open – Classification for a person not eligible as a Junior or Amateur. Amateurs may participate in the Open Year-End High Percentage Award Program.

Award Year:

The Award Year will run from Oct. 1st of the previous year through Sept. 30th of the present year.

Qualification:

An individual is to be a GLDC member, in good standing, at the time the scores are earned.

The Year-End High Percentage Award is given to one horse and rider combination and can only be earned once by that combination. An individual must participate in a GLDC- affiliated clinic or show; volunteer at an affiliated event; sponsor a GLDC schooling show class; instruct one or more students during a GLDC schooling show the year of the award; or attend 4 monthly GLDC meetings this year. Scores come from one horse and rider combination.

Three (3) submitted tests are to come from a minimum of two (2) different shows and two (2) different judges. Schooling and/or recognized show scores are eligible. Scores must come from judges that are "L" graduates or above.

Scoring:

The Year-End High Percentage Award is given to the horse and rider combination whose AVERAGE of the 3 submitted scores is the highest of all submitted horse and rider combination average scores.
