## PROFESSION of FAITH

## THE NICENE CREED

### SECOND READING

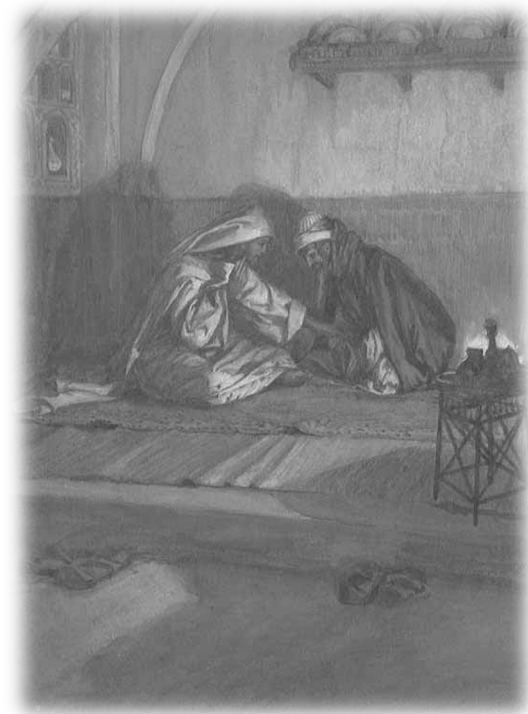
2 COR 13:11-13
