

Ask pupils to arrange the cards in a series of sets, so that a major unit contains all the minor units,

e.g.

England - Surrey, London, River Trent. Wales - Cardiff, Anglesey, Brecon Beacons.

The exact content on the cards can be tailored to the requirements of the pupils.

There are a number of variations that can be used in terms of sorting and generating discussion.
