The basketball goal is available to anyone and the playground has a slide, swings and sand play area. The sand volleyball court is available to the public except on Sundays during the volleyball season.

Over the years, the LHCC has had countless Easter egg hunts, Trunk or Treat events and Christmas parties for the children of Ft Wright. It is a landmark in the community. We are a local polling location for elections, a gathering place for many weddings, receptions, birthday parties, retirement events, celebration of life events, festivals, fireworks, etc. Other community enrichment contributions include:

- Hall donation for fundraising efforts for a terminal illness.
- Donations to the City and First responders of Ft Wright.
- Local Scholarships to graduating Seniors.
- Safety meeting by the Ft Wright Police
- We have quilters that sew during the week.
- Line Dancing every Wednesday morning.
- The building is open to about any group and purpose.
- It serves the community

We are in grave danger of losing the building and the Civic Club for good. We need all members to get involved. Our annual income does not cover the expenses plus the property taxes.
