The Christ Lutheran School Board is now making plans for the 2023/2024 school year. In order to do this accurately it is important for us to know how many students we can expect to attend next school year. We are asking you to prayerfully consider what your decision will be as soon as possible.

Current students enrolled at CLS get first placement if forms have been filled out online by March 1st. There is a limited number of students accepted in each class and with the increase of enrollments, please know that some classes may fill up quickly.
