

STORM WATER MASTER PLAN

The City of Duquesne has authorized Allgeier, Martin and Associates to help us with a Storm Water Master Plan. This Plan will assist us in developing projects for our future Storm Water needs. The process for collecting data will involve getting input from our residents to see where our most serious needs are. This will be done through public hearings. Please watch for these and attend if possible.

More Development may be on the way...

A public hearing will be held at City Hall on December 6, 2021 at 6:00 PM to discuss the development of an area on East 20th Street for more residential homes.
