## Missouri HOSA 2022 State Leadership Conference Recognition Event Guidelines and Deadlines

- Barbara James Service Award (*Refer to <u>https://hosa.org/wp-content/uploads/2021/08/21-22-BJSA-</u> <u>Aug20-FINAL.pdf</u> for Guidelines)* 
  - The State Leadership Conference deadline is February 15, 2022. Activities must be entered and APPROVED by local chapter advisors in the online HOSA Activity Tracking System by midnight of the deadline date.
  - Hours are pro-rated to 75 hours for SLC recognition. If a member has exceeded the 100 hours for ILC recognition, the Bronze/Silver/Gold award will be granted according to the guidelines.
    Awards will be given as follows at the SLC:
    - 75.0 99.9 Approved Hours = State Recognition Certificate
    - 100.0 174.9 Approved Hours = Bronze National Level Recognition
    - 175.0 249.9 Approved Hours = Silver National Level Recognition
    - 250.0+ Approved Hours = Gold National Level Recognition
- HOSA Happenings (Refer to <u>https://hosa.org/wp-content/uploads/2021/08/21-22-HOSA-Happenings-</u> <u>FINAL-Aug-20.pdf</u> for Guidelines)
  - The State Submission Process for this award will be **OPTION A** the PRINT submission, per the guidelines.
    - The print submission must include one print copy of the selected four (4) to eight (8) 8.5 x 11 inches pages of content.
    - AND the cover page found on page 5 of these guidelines, and
    - MUST BE RECEIVED by the chartered association HOSA office by the published deadline, which is 5:00 pm on Monday, March 28, 2022.
    - Print submissions should be on 8 ½ x 11" white paper, stapled at the top left corner, WITHOUT binding, sheet protectors, or contained in any type of folder or notebook.
  - Please bring the submission to HOSA Headquarters no later than 5:00 pm on Monday, March 28, 2022.
  - Submissions that earn 80 points or higher will be recognized at the chartered association level.
  - This event is not judged at the international level. All submissions earning a score of 80 points or higher at the chartered association level will be eligible for recognition at the HOSA International Leadership Conference. The names of those chapters who earn 80 points or higher will be submitted to HOSA—Future Health Professionals by the State Advisor.

- Healthcare Issues Exam (*Refer to <u>https://hosa.org/wp-content/uploads/2021/11/21-22-HCIE-FINAL-</u> <u>Nov15.pdf</u> for Guidelines)* 
  - Each state will be allowed to enter any qualified HOSA member, based on the formula listed in the guidelines. All Secondary and Postsecondary/Collegiate students registered for the SLC Qualifier are eligible to take the exam, but must register for this event. Middle School students may NOT take the Healthcare Issues Exam.
  - The chartered association test will cover information from July 1<sup>st</sup> November 1<sup>st</sup>. Dates for ILC testing will be from January 1<sup>st</sup> April 30<sup>th</sup>.
  - At the SLC, the top 10% will be recognized by reading a list of those names. The top scorer will receive special recognition and a certificate.
- HOSA Service Project (Refer to <u>https://hosa.org/wp-content/uploads/2021/08/21-22-HSP-FINAL-Aug-19.pdf</u> for Guidelines)
  - 2020-2022 Service Organization: Be The Match (<u>https://www.bethematchhosa.org/</u>)
  - Donations and volunteer hours will be tracked by the local chapter advisor. Donations should be noted on just ONE chapter member's account. (For example, if each member of chapter participated, but money was also raised, EVERY member can track the volunteer hours, but only ONE member will track the donation.)
  - For State recognition, this event may include activities from June 1, 2021-February 15, 2022.
    Activities must be entered and APPROVED by chapter advisors in the online HOSA Activity
    Tracking System by midnight on February 15, 2022. The list of activities in the system is what
    will be used to identify recognition levels at the State Leadership Conference.
  - State Certificates of Recognition will be awarded to all chapters who contribute a minimum of \$75.00 and/or 75 hours of community service in partnership with the organization.
  - State Certificates of Merit will be awarded to all chapters who contribute a minimum of \$375.00 and/or 375 hours of community service in partnership with the organization.

- **Outstanding HOSA Achievement** (*Refer to <u>https://hosa.org/wp-content/uploads/2021/08/21-22-OHA-</u> <u>FINAL-Aug-19.pdf</u> for Guidelines)* 
  - This event is designed to recognize chartered associations for their work creating and showcasing their Outstanding HOSA Achievement, along with individuals and chapters for participating in the Outstanding HOSA Achievement.
  - The submission for this event may not replicate any current HOSA event (i.e. HOSA Service Project).
  - To be eligible for this event, chartered associations of HOSA-Future Health Professionals must be in good standing. Each local chapter can submit one entry. In order to determine the ONE state entry submitted, any chapter wishing to apply for this achievement must submit their chapter's entry to the State Advisor by midnight on March 1, 2022 via email to <u>Shelly.Wehmeyer@dese.mo.gov</u>.
  - All entries will be considered and scored by a committee determined by the State Advisor, and the highest scoring entry based on the Rating Sheet will be submitted for International recognition.
