RECIPE FOR FOUR EGG SPONGE

4 Eggs

3/4 cup Castor Sugar

2 ounces butter

1 cup cornflour

3 teaspoons plain flour

1 teaspoon baking powder

Beat eggs until thick, gradually add sugar. Sift flour 3 times adding baking powder. Fold flours into egg and sugar mixture. Then add melted butter. Bake at 375 degrees F for 20 to 25 minutes. Cake to be un-iced and joined with gladwrap. Cook in two 18 cm round tins.
