Calverley Old Hall

Some interesting things you might like to know

- Calverley is mentioned in the Domesday Book in 1086
- The oldest parts of St Wilfrid's Church date back to the 11th century. It is thought, however, that a structure existed earlier on the site
- Calverley Old Hall (parts of which date to the 1400's) is now owned by the Landmark Trust
- Calverley is the setting for a play "The Yorkshire Tragedy" which tells the story of Walter Calverley who murdered two of his children, attempted to kill his wife
- Many of the houses in Calverley were former weavers cottages
- It is thought that Longfellow based his poem "Under the Spreading Chestnut Tree" on the old blacksmiths shop (now a house on Blackett Street)
- In WW2 there was a prisoner of war camp in Calverley Woods (traces of which can still be seen)
- Calverley won a "gold award" at Leeds in Bloom in 2012
