Q. What is the Lord's Supper?

A. The Lord's supper is a sacrament of the New Testament, in which, by giving and receiving bread and wine according to the institution of Jesus Christ, His death is showed forth; and they who faithfully commune feed upon His body and blood, to their spiritual nourishment and growth in grace; have their union and communion with Him confirmed; testify and renew their thankfulness, and engagement to God, and their mutual love and fellowship each with the other, as members of the same mystical body.

And the Pharisees and their scribes grumbled at His disciples, saying, "Why do you eat and drink with tax collectors and sinners?" And Jesus answered them, "Those who are well have no need of a physician, but those who are sick. I have not come to call the righteous but sinners to repentance."

O Lord our God, we ought to tremble with fear, for You know us better than we know ourselves. You know the full depth of our wicked hearts and our depraved desires; You know how feebly we have fought against the "desires of the flesh;" You know how bored we have become with the things of Christ because we have forgotten what we deserve. What we deserve is Your wrath; ashes should rightfully be our inheritance. We do not deserve to call out to You and plead for mercy as we confess our sins, yet we pray to You anyway. Please forgive us, please show mercy to us, please pardon us of all of our sins because the Lord

Jesus Christ drank the cup of Your wrath down to the very dregs.


