

NEW C.M.E. PASTOR ARRIVES



The Rev. E. M. Radford is newly-appointed pastor of Trinity C.M.E. Church, 345 N. Jackson St. to fill the post of the Rev. J. P. Davis, who left last week for a New Madrid, Mo., church. The Rev. Mr. Radford comes to Decatur from the Metropolitan C.M.E. Church at Danville, where in the last two years he was successful in leading the congregation to the building of a new \$75,000 church. A veteran of 28 years in the ministry, the Rev. Mr. Radford was organizer of Third Congregational Church

in Gary, Ind. He received his training from Mississippi Industrial College and Northwestern University. Mrs. Radford is a former public schools teacher. She received her training at Texas College, Tyler, Tex., the Rochester Business Institute and the Mechanic Institute, both in Rochester, N.
