

Amended Resolution No. 3-17-97

WHEREAS, the following described road was laid out in the plat of Indian Mound Subdivision, a part of Government Lot #2 of Section 35, Township 22 North, Range 11 East, Waupaca, recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds, Waupaca County, on August 22, 1939, in Volume 4 of Plats on page 16:

WHEREAS, the above described property has been entirely abandoned as a route of travel, and no highway funds have been expended for five years,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: by the Town Board of the Town of Farmington that, pursuant to Section 80.32(2), Wisconsin Statutes, the following described property is considered discontinued:
