## F.A.Q's

1. **Where will the creative learning program be located?** We come to YOU! Programs must be located in a private home in the GTA (Expansion coming soon). See additional host site requirements below.
2. **Can the Program switch location to different host houses within the group?** Our host parent will receive 50% off the program for hosting the program for the duration of the Fall session. The program cannot be switched until the Winter session. If it is switched there is no 50% incentive to the main host.
3. **What's included?** Every two weeks we will have a special theme and each site will have their own group leader facilitating the fun and creative learning!  
JCK provides all the program supplies, sports equipment, music and more! Program will also include visits from Head Staff/ specialty guest appearances!
4. **Can I put together my own group of 5?** Yes you could put together your own group of family and friends. If you don't have 5 kids the group fee will be higher per child or we will match you up with another child looking for a group.
5. **What if I have more than 5 kids?** We are only accepting 5 kids in our creative recreational program.
6. **Can we select different hours?** Yes you may request alternate hours (9AM-12PM). The schedule will implement additional free play in place of lunch.
7. **Can I have children from other families in my group?** Yes, and if so, we will be operating according to policies based on the Toronto Public Health social distance guidelines for summer day camps.
8. **Can my group start late?** Please inquire via email at [vered@jckcamps.com](mailto:vered@jckcamps.com)
9. **Is there camp on Civic Holidays and Jewish Holidays?** The following dates are off.  
(Please note - There is no charge on vacation days)  
**Sept.28th**  
**Oct. 5th-Oct. 12th**  
**Fall Program ends Dec. 18th (Prior to December break)**
10. **Can the participants change within my group?** Participants ideally need to be the same group for a session. If a participant wishes to withdraw from the program they will need to find another participant to fill their spot. There are no refunds for the program as your child is taking the spot since only 5 children are being accepted for each recreational group.
11. **What ages is this geared towards?** The program is geared towards ages 2-6. We understand that some groups will be mixed age, and others will be for similar ages. Activities and programming will be adjusted to meet the needs of each group.
12. **Do I have to commit to all the weeks?** Yes, in order to be considered a host site you and your group of 5 must commit to all the weeks of the session.
13. **What type of program/activities will you be running?** Daily activities will include arts & crafts, STEM, Creative Movement, outdoor play, free play, special Friday activities and more!

**14. Will the groups be able to go off site to a local park, slurpee walks etc?** Due to COVID-19 and general safety all activities will take place at the host site.

**15. What happens in the event of rain?** Our fall program is meant to run indoors so we would require an indoor space with easy bathroom access at the host site. The space will be set up indoors (near a washroom) and outdoor play will take place in the backyard.

**16. Is food provided?**

Participants need to provide their own snacks and drinks. Food will not be served at the program.

**17. I want to host a group at my house. What's required?**

- Indoor space with Table & Chairs and easy access to a washroom with a stool for younger children.
- Outdoor backyard space
- Access to refrigerator / freezer for food and first aid storage
- Access to working phone line (emergencies only)

**18. Do I need to be at home at all times?** As the host you are not required to be home at all times. If you are out of the home head staff will require access to your home during the duration of the program. (Email us to inquire- [vered@jckcamps.com](mailto:vered@jckcamps.com) )

**19. Do you have a behaviour policy?** Yes, please click [here](#) for our Parent & Camper Behaviour policy.

**20. What health & safety policies will be in place?** More details can be found on the JCK Camp Updates page on our website.

- Our staff will complete health and safety and first aid training prior to the start of camp via Zoom.
- Staff will wear gloves during activities with shared materials and replace them after each activity.
- Your group leader will wear a mask indoors as well as if they are required to be closer than 2m to a camper in order to assist them (depends on the group). Group leaders are not required to wear masks outdoors however if you have any concerns please let us know.
- JCK will provide and utilize fun props to emphasize the importance of personal space in a friendly way. Each camper will get a personal hula hoop to be used for sports and fun fitness while also assisting with physical distancing.
- All sites and staff will be provided with thermometer, sanitizer, and cleaning products for daily cleaning of common areas.

21. **Is your camp insured?** Yes we are insured however all participants are required to sign a Covid-19 Waiver. We will continue to touch base with our insurance company as more information is announced regarding Covid-19.
22. **Will I need to sign a waiver?** Each parent/guardian will be required to sign an agreement outlining our policies with respect to COVID-19 and general health and safety protocols.
23. **Are there refunds in the event that the program site is cancelled for any reason?** Refunds will only be issued due to a Covid-19 related matter. Refunds will be based on a prorated amount based on the number of days remaining.
