We are so excited and grateful to be back at dance class! If you are new to our studio, welcome and we hope your child falls in love with dance!

Our Fifth Group, Sixth Group and Pep Elite started technique classes is November. We developed a strong base for learning and developing our technical skills and were so excited to start choreography! We were also able to learn about each other and make thanksgiving cards for a special person in our lives. We have had a great start to the year and pray for God's hand of protection and blessing to continue to be over us.

Some apparel items and shoes have been back-ordered. We worked on finding substitutions that were acceptable. All other items should arrive between December-January. As soon as your items arrive, we will hand them out at class. For the items you have received, please keep in mind that we cannot replace items that have been worn. Tags must remain attached and items need to be in original bagging in order to exchange for a different size.

As a reminder, masks are optional at this time. If your dancer is feeling ill, we ask that you keep them home from class. If they are experiencing symptoms of COVID-19, threw up or have diarrhea the day of class, and/or have a temperature (without the use of fever reducing-medication), please keep them home. Attending class is still very important to your child's learning, however, we understand that the pandemic may interfere and want you to do what is best for everyone's health. We will do our very best to ensure your child catches up if they miss a class or two. Please email or call to let us know that your dancer will be absent.

Note From Mrs. Tina about Winter:

As we find ourselves in the beginning of winter, we just want to remind everyone to please walk on the perimeter of the room by the chairs (and entrances) and not through the middle of the dance floor. Please keep an eye on little ones as well so our floor stays clean and safe for our dancers! Only dance shoes should be in the middle of the floor. Thank you for your help!

We follow the Oconto Falls School District for weather cancellations. If school is cancelled due to any other reason such as teacher in-service, etc. this does not mean dance is cancelled. Scheduled cancellations will be listed in the newsletters. On the day of an inclement weather cancellation, you will receive a text message notification and email.
