Poet Emily Isaacson will be releasing her thirteenth book of poetry this Saturday, October 22. The book is titled, *Love in the Time of Plague*. She has been collecting her recent poetry during the time of the pandemic, and offers over 85 pages of new poetry in this 271 page paperback and commemorative hardcover edition. Her commitment to correspondence is one of the things she has done during a decade of being a poet in print, starting with her first collection in three volumes, *The Fleur-de-lis* in 2011. She has given out over 2,000 cards over the years at Christmas to both individuals and community builders. Isaacson is a Goodreads and Amazon author and has almost 4,000 books in print. Her new book is published by Potter's Press. Plan to attend this next launch at Clearbrook Library in Abbotsford, Saturday, Oct 22 from 2-4 p.m. hosted by the Fraser Valley Poets Society and have a book signed.
