

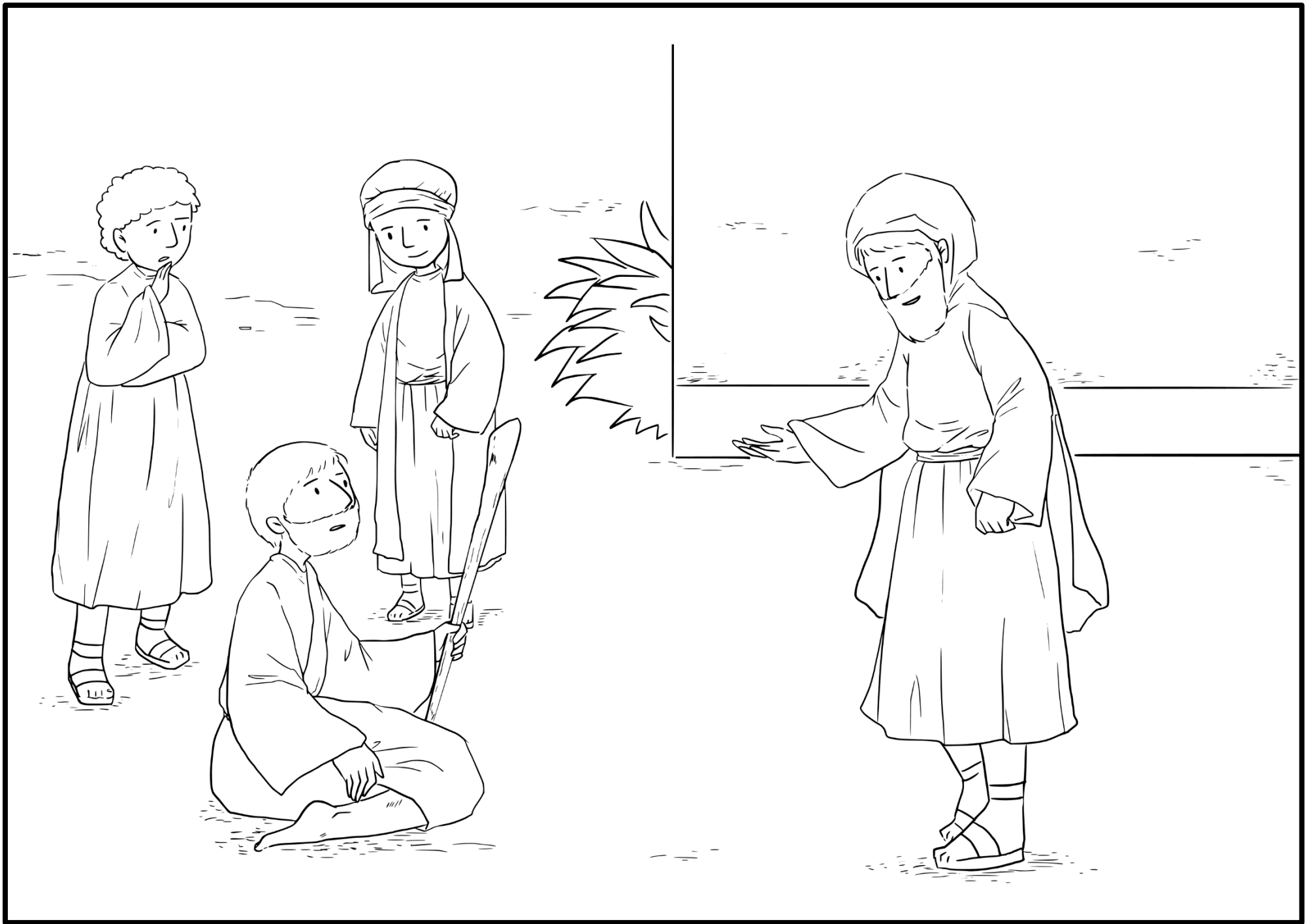

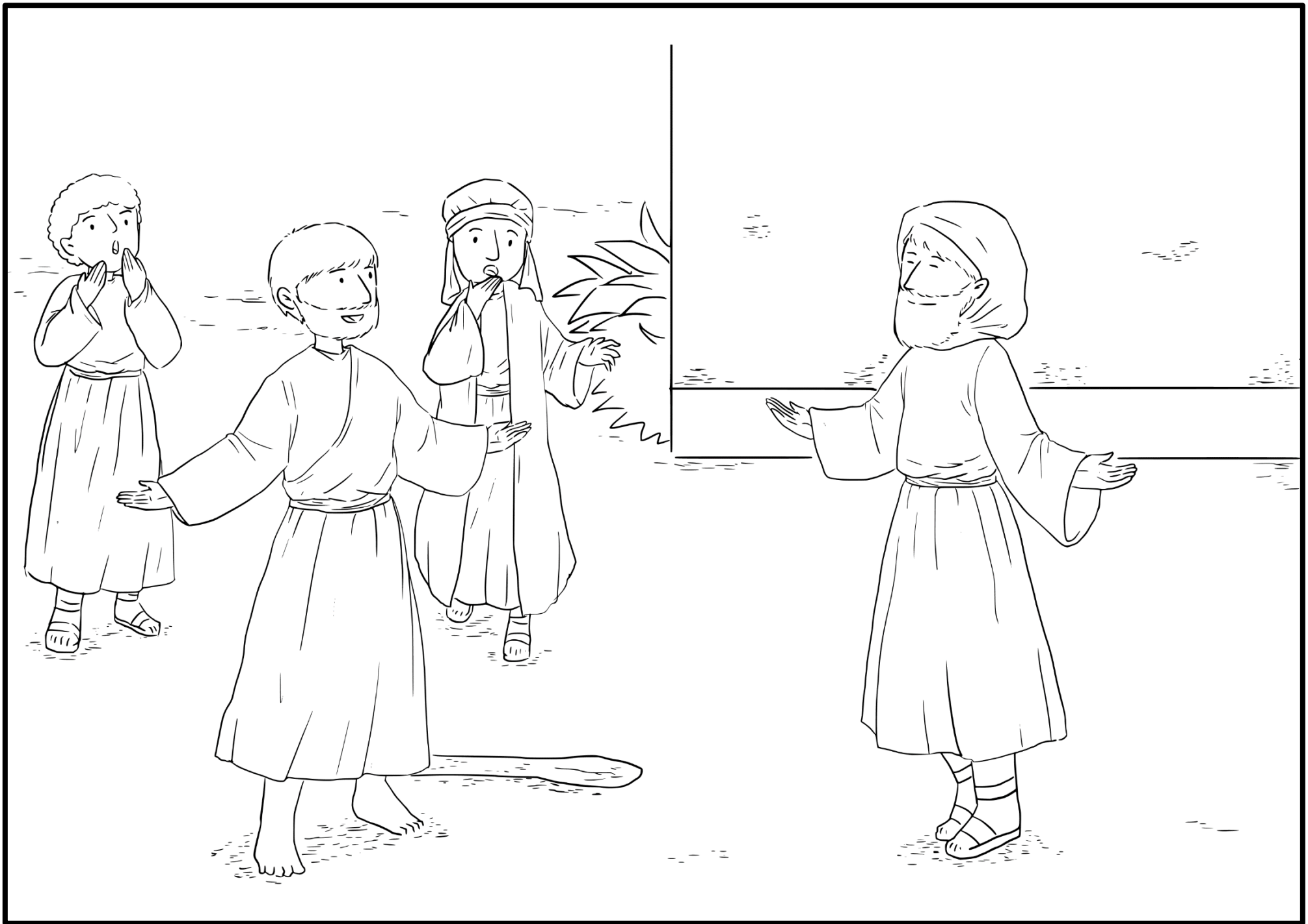

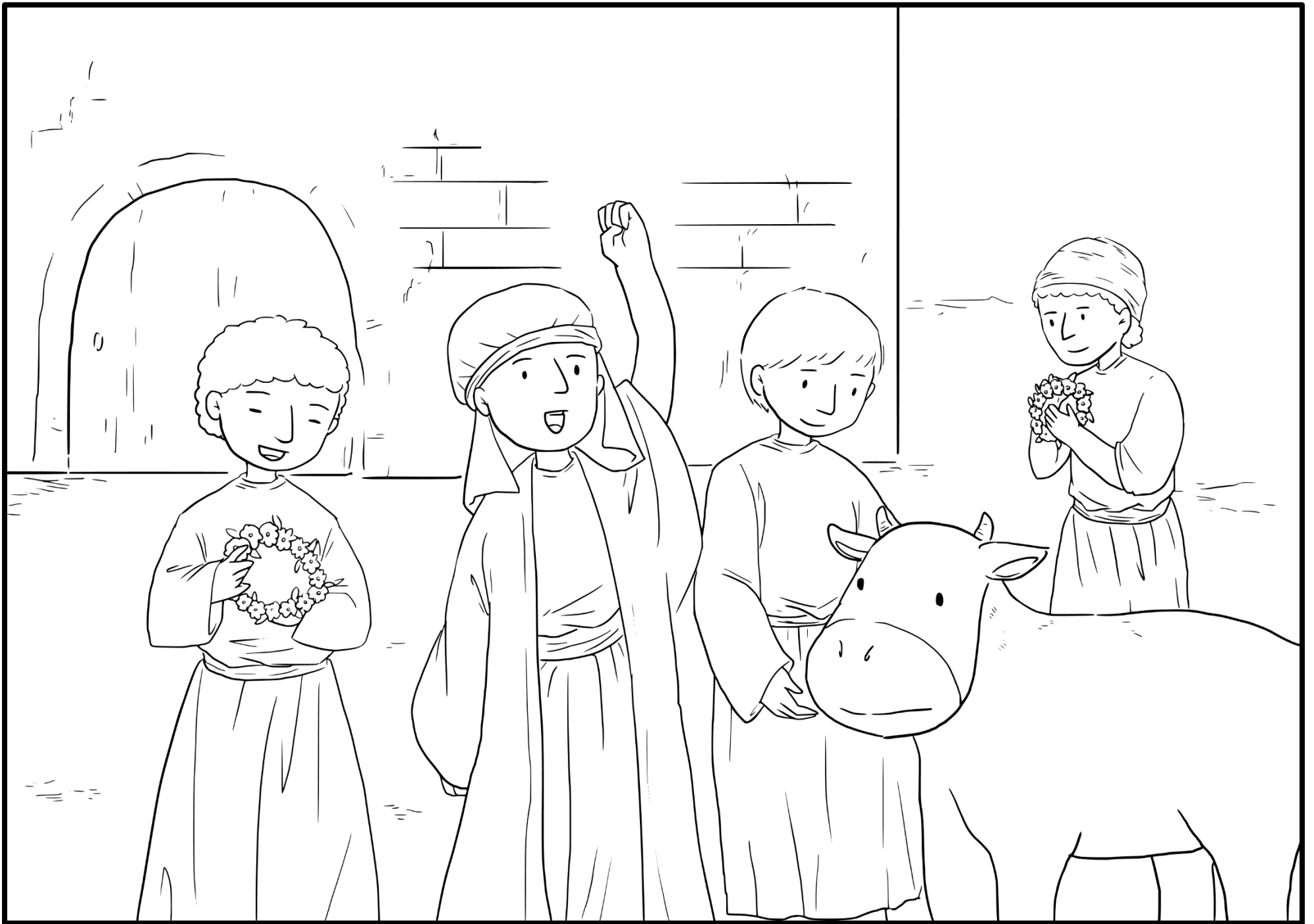




And a certain man was sitting in Lystra, who was afflicted lame in the feet from his mother's womb, who had never walked – Acts 14:8

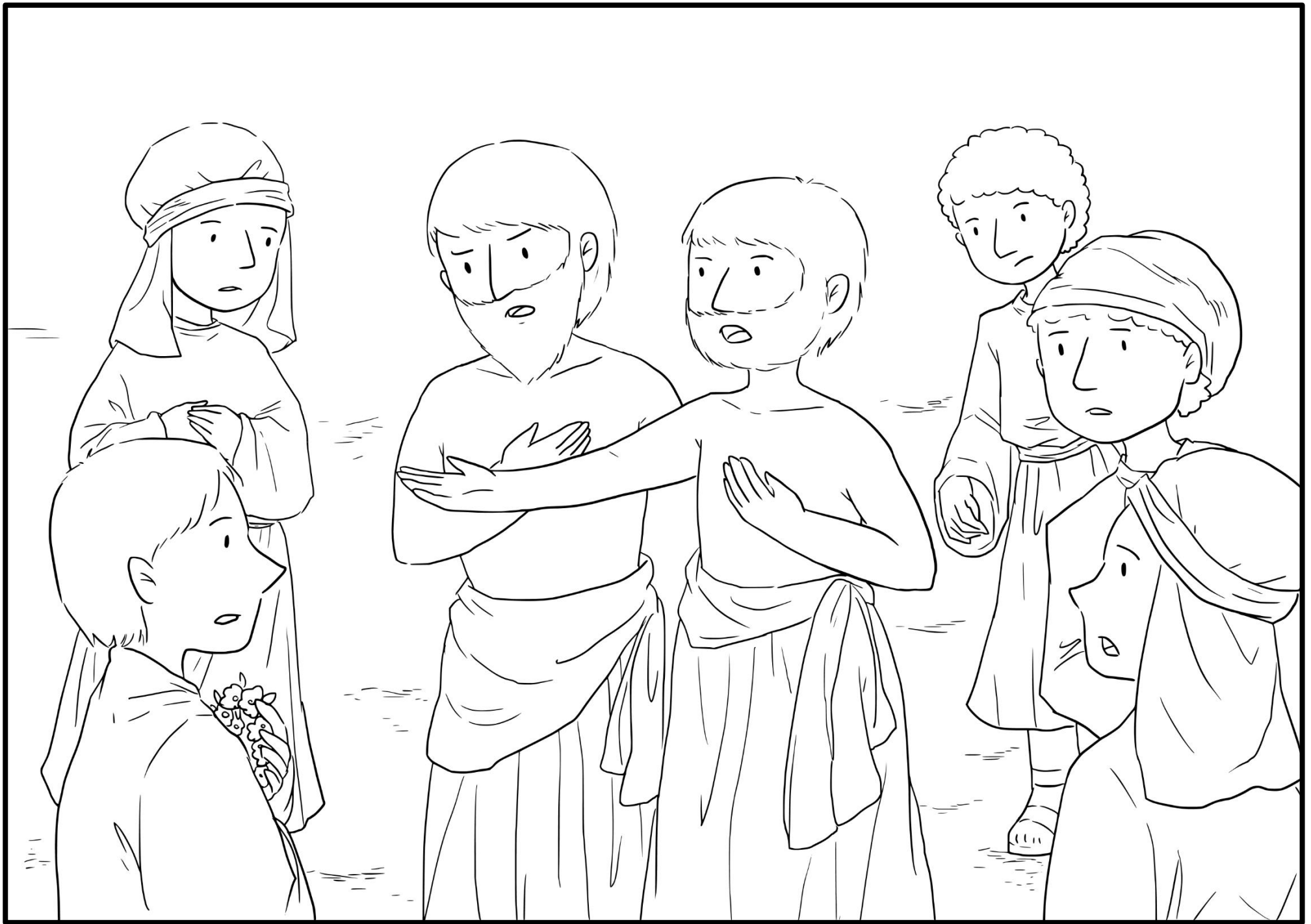
