The bitterness I had in me not only destroyed my relationship with God, it also allowed my husband to become bitter towards me as well. When a relationship bares bitterness, the sweetness fades away.

God's word states that our husbands should have no place in their hearts to be bitter toward their wives. He specifies that husbands should love their wives and wives should submit to their husbands.

When you are bitter it leads to envy and selfseeking in your heart, wherever envy and self-seeking exist, confusion and every evil thing will be there. If you allow bitterness in your life, you become poisoned by bitterness. Therefore submit to God. Draw near to God and He will draw near to you.

Don't cover up lies with sweetness. Human nature allows us to think that a lie is acceptable, even pleasing to our ears, if it is what our heart wants to hear. The truth is our ears love sweet lies as much as our tongues love sugar.

Like all addictions, we tend to underestimate or disregard the hold sweet lies can have on us until some unfortunate incident occurs, forcing us to face reality.

Believing the sweet lie of sugar, many go from wanting something desirable yet destructive, to needing something desirable and destructive in greater and greater quantities. The more sugar you eat, the more you want; all the while dismissing the damage it was doing to your body. It is no different with words. Once we contemplate sweet lies and then partake of them, we become, over time, increasingly dependent on them to get us through the day and maintain the same level of satisfaction.

Suffice it to say; entertaining sweet lies is a

slippery slope; which is why we are commanded in scripture, time and again, to avoid anyone who repeatedly adds to, subtracts from or contradicts God's Word.

We wonder why year after year we stay in the same season. We pray, ask God, "Why am I not receiving my blessings? "Why am I suffering from someone else's affliction?" You can not fake bitterness; our hearts are what they are in the sight of God, who cannot be deceived. And if they are not right in his sight, our religion is vain, and will stand us in no stead. A proud and covetous heart cannot be right with God.

Psalm 110:103 How sweet are your words to my taste, Sweeter than honey to my mouth! David took pleasure and delight in the word of God, it was sweet to his taste, sweeter than honey. He experienced spiritual taste, an inward savour and relish of divine things. The word of God is sweet, very sweet, and sweeter than any of the gratifications of sense, even those that are most delicious.

With that said, we know it is definitely time to get rid of the bitterness and let God bless you with the sweetness of life. I had to choose whether to let go of the bitterness and keep the marriage or keep the bitterness and let go of the marriage. I finally surrendered and chose to let go of the bitterness. I wanted to restore my relationship back with God and experience the spiritual taste of sweetness that He had to offer.

Genesis 1:1 In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. The world and all things in it were created by God. These were God's new beginnings. As Christians we should be mindful of our duties, which are always to keep heaven in our eye, and the earth under our feet.

In closing, your new beginnings starts with your choice of letting the bitterness go. God hears, sees, and knows everything that you



went through. The unfolding happens when you have released the bitterness, so you can now embrace the new beginnings of what God has for you. LIVING BY THE SPIRIT

For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit. For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace. Because the carnal mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be. So then they that are in the flesh cannot please God. Romans 8:5-8

We have been called out from darkness into the light by the leading of God's Holy Spirit and saved according to the crucifixion, death, and resurrection of our Savior, Jesus Christ. Therefore we have been freed and given a new beginning! In this chapter Paul reminds us that there is no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit, Romans 8:1. Therefore our minds are to be set on the things of the spirit. We may be in a fleshly body but we have been given the promise of God, who brings to us all power and authority to guide us into truth, The Holy Spirit.

Paul goes on to talk about two types of people, the people who are controlled by their sinful nature and those who are controlled by the leading of the Holy Spirit. Prior to salvation, we were all controlled by our flesh, many operating with no self control. But, after accepting Jesus, we must continue to follow him, denying our selfish desires and do the will He's called us to do, become Christ like.

The process to become Christ like is not overnight. It is indeed a process, one in which we will be tested to be strengthened. God led the Israelites into the wilderness to humble them and test what was in their hearts (Deuteronomy 8:2). We will have to be humbled and we most certainly need to prove to God that whatever works His Holy Spirit does through us that He can trust it will be done with a clean heart. Whatever tests we are given know that we can conquer, as Jesus was tested in Matthew chapter four. Therefore follow Jesus' example and defeat the devil with the Word. Therefore do not lean to your own understandings, daily surrender yourself to the leading of the Holy Spirit, read God's word so you might gain a deeper understanding; as the Sprint brings about correction your character will change, and you will begin to bear fruit.

I went through a phase of life where "I" was trying to change my life and get my flesh under control. God allowed me to go through this phase so that I might recognize that it's not me who brings about change. It's me putting me aside and surrendering to the Holy Spirit that brings about change.

Once I removed myself, I began to hear from the Lord and get a deeper revelation of His Word. Even in the bearing of fruit, I still learn because "I" was looking at it with no confidence thinking I can't be used. But, God has given me peace to know, it's not my words. I felt as though God would never forgive me for things I did and that my life was finished. But, I want you to know God is a God of a Second Chance and New beginnings.

- New Heavens and New Earth.. 2 Peter 3:13

- New Way to the Father..Hebrews 10:19-20

The devil (our enemy) wants to keep you and me in bondage to fear and dread which leads to discouragement, despair, and depression. But the "God of Hope" wants to fill us with joy and peace as you trust Him. For his mercies is new every morning, according to Lamentations 3:22-23, 25, "His mercies never fail...they are new ever morning. We can start over again just as nothing ever happened.

I am a true witness that my God is a God of a Second Chance and a new beginning. My new beginning started in 2009 at Sister Circle Ministry while I was in deep despair. God placed me in the hands of a wonderful woman of God who had the compassion of Jesus who loved and encouraged me to get up. That's when I began walking in my new beginning. Today, I am walking in a new beginning like Lamentations 3:22-23 encourages us to do and to receive the Lord's mercies that we may not be consumed by our problem, disappointment, hurt, and sin. I encourage you to seize your new beginning and Second Chance as Zacchaeus did in Luke 19:8 when he stood and said to the Lord, "look, Lord!" Here and now I give half of my possessions to the poor and if I have cheated anybody out of anything, I will pay back four times the amount. So you stand up and seize your new beginning and second chance by confession to God all that you are going through or what you need to repent of.

In closing let me encourage you today to begin to walk in your new beginning.
