God's People Confess Their Faith: WLC 167

Q. How is our baptism to be improved by us?

A. The needful but much neglected duty of improving our baptism, is to be performed by us all our life long, especially in the time of temptation, and when we are present at the administration of it to others; by serious and thankful consideration of the nature of it and of the ends for which Christ instituted it, the privileges and benefits conferred and sealed, and our solemn vow made therein; by being humbled for our sinful defilement, our falling short of and walking contrary to the grace of baptism; by growing up to assurance of pardon of sin, and of all other blessings sealed to us in that sacrament; by drawing strength from the death and resurrection of Christ, into whom we are baptized, for the killing of sin, and enlivening of grace; and by endeavoring to live by faith, to have our conversation in holiness and righteousness, as those that have therein given up their names to Christ; and to walk in brotherly love, as being baptized by the same Spirit into one body.

God Calls Us to Repentance: Isaiah 55:1-2

Come, everyone who thirsts, come to the waters; and he who has no money, come, buy and eat! Come, buy wine and milk without money and without price. Why do you spend your money for that which is not bread, and your labor for that which does not satisfy? Listen diligently to me, and eat what is good, and delight you selves in rich food.

Almighty and Everlasting God, we praise You for making Your-

O Father, forgive us for our sinful defilement, forgive us for not striving to walk in brotherly love, and forgive us for cherishing the things of this world more than the heavenly inheritance of all Your people through Christ.
