ORDINANCE NO. 1175

AN ORDINANCE

PROHIBITING OWNERS/~~OF DOGS~~ OR CATS TO PERMIT THEM TO RUN AT LARGE, OR TO MAKE EXCESSIVE NOISE; AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Connellsville, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same.

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any owner or or keepers owners/of dogs or cats to permit the same to run at large within the City of Connellsville.

SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful for any owner or or keepers owners/of dogs or cats to permit the same to make excessive noise to the disturbance, annoyance or fright of persons in the vicinity or passersby.

SECTION 3. It shall be unlawful for any owner or or keepers owners/of dogs or cats to keep the same when the animal exhibits a habit of making excessive noise to the disturbance, annoyance or fright of persons in the vicinity or passersby.

SECTION 4. Any person who shall be convicted of a violation of any of the provisions of this Ordinance before the District Magistrate shall be sentenced to pay a fine of

not more than Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars, together with costs of prosecution, or to imprisonment in the county jail for a term not to exceed thirty (30) days.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after its enactment.
