



Ian Mountain Peugeot Special Restoration

We have always had some very knowledgeable, passionate and unassuming members in our car club when it comes to ensuring older cars, whether as transport of the past, recreational vehicles or motorsport, are not forgotten and are preserved for all generations to enjoy.

One of our club members, Dick Willis, has certainly made many contributions to this cause and his recent project is a another great example.

Following is a report from Dick which I am sure will be of great interest to our club members and other car clubs that receive our newsletter. EDITOR

I thought your Idle Torque readers might be interested in the latest episode of the Ian Mountain Peugeot Special restoration story where it was unveiled to the Historic racing fraternity at the Historic Winton race meeting on May 27/28/29.

Since the accident which claimed the life of it's creator, Ian Mountain, at the Gnoo Blas circuit at Orange in January 1955, the car had never been repaired after suffering severe damage in the accident. In fact, many were unaware that it still existed although it was in the hands of a Victorian enthusiast for almost 50 years but progress on it's restoration was very slow.

I took over the project in January last year and accompanied by another club member, Tony Goninan, travelled to Melbourne to collect the project. When Tony first viewed the "car" he was sceptical that anyone could ever bring it back to life but just 12 months later, after a lot of thought, effort and dollars it was mobile again.

At Winton it was a featured display attracting much interest and favourable comment as although the car had been widely featured in the motor sporting press at the time of it's inception few had ever actually seen the car in the flesh. Originally the special was said to have a high standard of finish and many commented that this, and many features of it's advanced design, were evident in the restored car.

While in Victoria the opportunity was taken to show the car to Ian Mountain's surviving brother, 89 year old Ken Mountain, who is shown in the attached picture with the car.



When a hot Twin Cam model was revealed only two months after the all-new Escort's UK launch in 1968, Ford's sporting intentions were clear. What followed was a series of brilliant competition-bred Escorts that would take the motor sport world by storm.

The stylish newcomer offered a choice of robust 'Kent' cross-flow four cylinder engines in a light but rigid unitary body-shell. MacPherson strut front suspension, a conventional leaf-sprung live rear axle plus rack and pinion steering resulted in a rugged but simple car that was a born athlete.

Ford star Allan Moffat was the most high profile driver to race an Escort in Australia, when he drove this superb ex-Alan Mann Racing Cosworth FVA-powered version in the early 1970s. Here the Escort is captured in full flight at Sydney's Warwick Farm Raceway in early 1971, just after it had been repainted in Coca-Cola red. Note how the sign-writer misspelt the driver's name. Not a Ford fan obviously.
