In addition it was determined that the District needs to look at hiring an administrative officer to help the chief. Motion by Clerk/Director Carlson, Seconded by Director Jacquez. - 8. <u>Executive Session</u> The executive session was cancelled at the request of Chief Rod Prost. Therefor the Fire Chiefs's Performance Evaluation and Job interview was conducted in Open session per advice of Counsel.

9. <u>Discussion, possible action regarding the Fire Chief's Performance Evaluation and employment</u>

Brief discussion by the board on the strengths and weakness of the Chief Prost. It was noted that he was an excellent grant writer and did a good job with accounting. He also did a good job of helping to form the district. After discussion of the Chief Rod Prost's performance a motion was made by Director Carlson terminate Chief's volunteer appointment to Fire Chief, seconded by Director Jacquez. Motion passes 3 votes.
