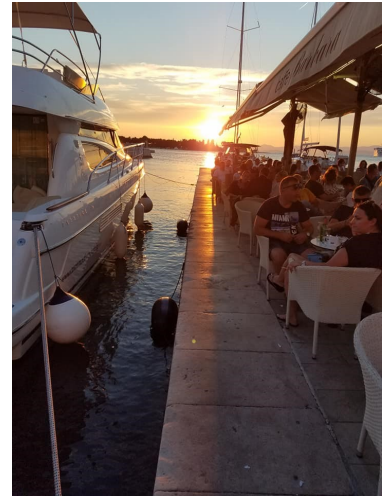


Wine, Wonders, & Mysteries of the Adriatic

Pair these wines with an excellent spread of cheeses, prosciutto, bread, olive oil made by the winery, and beautiful views of the Adriatic Sea.

Continue the wine affair to an old world tasting room on the island of Brac. Feel like a family member as you taste the locally made wines, cheese, and olive oil. Truly a cultural experience!

Stay the first 4 nights on the island of Brac in a modern 2 bedroom, 2 bathroom apartment, 100 meters from the beach! Relax on the beach and dive into the iridescent waters of the Adriatic. Explore the island on a private day tour to the diverse villages highlighting an original stone carver's school and an olive oil museum for a tour and tastings! Spend the remaining two nights on the mainland in a hotel in Split. Take a private tour around the city in a TukTuk and wander through the 1,700 year old walls of Diocletian's Palace, alive today with markets, trinket vendors, and restaurants.
