Here begins the Register of Marriages since the beginning

- Anterior to anno 1716
- 22 Junij 1716 James Brown in the parish of Kirkcubright having a
testimoniall from the Kirk Session of that parish and Marion Anderson
in this parish gave up yr names to be proclaimed in order
to marriage & after proclamation on three Sabbath
days were married yr after on the 15 Novr 1716.
- July 4th 1716 Thomas Inglis in the parish of Carnath & Elizabeth Johnson
in this parish (the said Thomas having produced sufficient
testimony in his favour from the Kirk Session of his parish) gave
up yr Names to be proclaimed in order to marriage and after
proclamation on three Sabbath days they were married
upon the 24 August 1716
- August 29th 1716 James Paterson in the parish of Woulton & Helen
Crichton in this parish were married this day they having given
up their names and also a few weeks ago to be proclaimed in
order to marriage which was legally done & they married as it is.
- Novr 20th 1717 James Noble in Dawick parish having a sufficient testimoniall
from the Session of that parish and Christian Noble in this parish gave up
yr Names to be proclaimed in order to marriage & after legal
proclamation on 3 Sabbath days received testimony of that
Session.
- Novr 29th 1717 William Law & Marion Brown were married this day
being legally proclaimed in order yr names.
- March 14th 1718 years James Galloway & Jean Murray both in this
parish gave up their names to be proclaimed in order
to marriage & after proclamation on three Sabbath
days were married upon the 15th of April 1718 years.
- April 11th 1718 John Ross & Christian Leitch both in this parish gave
up yr names to be proclaimed in order to marriage and
after proclamation on three Sabbath days were married
upon the 2^d of May yr after.
- May 21st 1718 John Lapslie in the parish of Morrain & Marion
Nair in this parish gave up yr Names to be proclaimed
in order to marriage the said John having produced
sufficient testimony in his favour, and after proclamation
on three Sabbath days were married shortly yr after
at Edz by Mr Gilchrist Deane
