

ORDINANCE NO. 06-10-13(2013)

ORDINANCE ADOPTING AN AMENDMENT TO THE
COMPREHENSIVE PLAN FOR THE TOWN OF FARMINGTON

The Town Board of the Town of Farmington, Waupaca County Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Section(s) 62.23/61.35/60.22(3) of the *Wisconsin Statutes*, the Town of Farmington is authorized to prepare and adopt a comprehensive plan as defined in Sections 66.1001(1)(a) and 66.1001(2) of the *Wisconsin Statutes*.

SECTION 2. The Town Board, by the enactment of an ordinance, formally adopted the document titled *Ordinance No. 08-07-07(2007) An Ordinance to Adopt The Town of Farmington Year 2030 Comprehensive Plan* on August 7, 2007.

SECTION 3. The Plan Commission, by a majority vote of the entire Commission at a meeting held on **May 7, 2013**, recommended to the Town Board the adoption of an amendment to change the land use designation of land as described or mapped on attached Exhibit A on the future land use map adopted as part of the comprehensive plan.

SECTION 4. The Town published or posted a Class 1 public notice and held a public hearing regarding the plan amendment.


SECTION 5. The Town Board of the Town of Farmington, Waupaca County, Wisconsin hereby adopts the proposed plan amendment.

SECTION 6. The Town Clerk is directed to send a copy of this ordinance and the plan amendment to the parties listed in Section 66.1001(4)(b) of the *Wisconsin Statutes*.


SECTION 7. This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage by a majority vote of the full membership of the Town Board and publication or posting as required by law.


