PROPOSED SIGN ORDINANCE MEETING
JUNE 15, 2021 AT 5:30 PM

The following resolution was introduced at the May 18, 2021 City Council Meeting:

***RESOLUTION:** “To introduce Bill # 1 of 2021: AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONNELLSVILLE, FAYETTE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, This Ordinance shall be known as the Sign Ordinance of the City of Connellsville, Fayette County, Pennsylvania. The purposes of these sign regulations are to encourage the effective use of signs as a means of identification and communication, to maintain and enhance the aesthetic environment of the City of Connellsville, to enhance pedestrian and vehicular safety, and to promote and protect the public health, safety, morals, and the general welfare of the City by avoiding the uncontrolled proliferation of signs.”

The meeting was to allow the public’s input on this ordinance before City Council’s meeting on this date at 6 PM.

Attending this meeting were Mayor Lincoln, Council members Tzan, Karpiak, Keedy and Topper. Also attending were City Clerk Ohler and Solicitor Witt.
