The Changi Cross was designed, constructed and engraved by three prisoners of war in Changi, Singapore in 1942. It was taken home to the UK after the war and brought back to Changi Museum in 1992.

CONTEMPORARY ART MODULE STARTS 15TH SEPTEMBER 2020

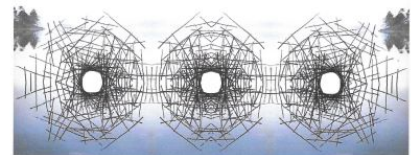

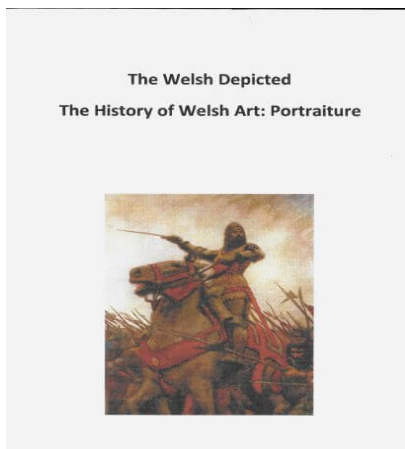
