- Our nation was founded on the principles of liberty, justice, and the idea that all people should have a voice in their government.
- But the current government has been built on political campaigns funded by rich, corporate special interests, with very little representation for the 99%.
- Reforming campaign finance laws and including all political parties in debates will return to a government of the people, by the people, and for the people.

Over \$6.28 billion were spent in the 2012 federal elections, and the winners of each congressional race spent an average of 63.5% more than the losers of each congressional race, highlighting a clear correlation between wealth and power.

WE WILL:

 Prohibit corporations from spending to influence elections, preferably by constitutional amendment abolishing corporate personhood.

WE WILL:

 Enact proportional representation voting systems for legislative seats and Instant Runoff Voting (IRV) for executive offices on all levels of government.

Other countries, such as the Federal Republic of Germany, have proven that public campaign financing can help all parties have a voice, and help the people, rather than corporations, be better represented.

WE WILL:

 Provide full public financing for all elections, including free and equal radio and television time on public airwaves.

THERE IS NO WAY TO PEACE PEACE IS THE WAY **#PEACENOW**

- Our nation has the potential to be a leading advocate for peace and diplomacy in the international forum.
- But the two major parties have consistently advocated for war, arms production, a bloated military budget, and maintained nuclear arms.
- Elected Greens would advocate for the opposite, valuing human lives higher than profits, corporate greed, or a sense of American exceptionalism.

 Work with other nations to limit and dismantle all nuclear arms.

 Support the United Nations as a forum for diplomacy and recognize the obligation of our government to enforce Security Council resolutions

 Disarm militarized police departments to ensure that the people are under their protection, not under attack.

LIBERTY AND JUSTICE FOR ALL #SOCIALJUSTICE

- Over the past century, the USA has made large strides towards providing all people with equal opportunities and protections under the law.
- But millions are still persecuted and denied the rights and privileges of a US citizen due to their race, sex, ideology, and other discriminatory factors.
- We can achieve equality for all people if we work with communities to stop the hardships that they face on a daily basis.

Women earn an average of 82% of what their male counterparts earn, African Americans are imprisoned disproportionately to European Americans, and the average undergraduate who takes out loans graduates \$30,000 in debt.

WE WILL:

 Call for the passage of the Equal Rights
Amendment and the Convention on the Elimination of all forms of Discrimination
Against Women.

WE WILL:

 Provide free college tuition to all qualified students at public universities and vocational schools.

GOOD NEWS

Countries around the world, such as Canada, have already adopted laws that provide groups that are generally discriminated against with equal protections, and a variety of countries have committed to limiting the amount of debt students incur.

WE WILL:

 Curb institutional racism by eradicating poverty, investing in education, protecting human rights, and ending the criminalization of minority communities.

FOSSIL FREE, AFFORDABLE ENERGY #SAFECLIMATE

- In the last thirty years there has been an explosion in public environmental awareness and activism, with little action from Congress or the Presidency.
- Governments must also prioritize action on climate change to avoid devastating harm to our economy, society and environment.
- A rapid transition to a zero-carbon sustainable economy will create millions of jobs and secure a safe climate for our children and grandchildren.

Climate change resulting in a warming of 3° Celsius is projected to cost the United States \$150 Billion per year, and a warming of 4° Celsius is projected to cost the United States over \$300 billion.

 Ban fracking, phase out coal power stations, and say "no" to new nuclear power plants.

 Take urgent action on climate change and work with other countries to hold the increase in global temperature to below 2° Celsius.

In 2012, Austria, New Zealand, and Iceland all generated more than 60% of their energy from renewables. Meanwhile, the United States was stuck at a shameful 12.5%.

 Develop affordable mass transit systems that are more economical to use than private vehicles.

HEALTH CARE IS A HUMAN RIGHT #BETTERCARE

- The introduction of the Affordable Care Act has brought about a much needed, nation-wide discussion about the way our health care system works.
- However, an estimated 13% of Americans, over 10 million people, are still left uninsured, and more are strained by the financial burden.
- Adopting single-payer health care can save Americans and the Federal Government money while insuring all and increasing benefits.

Over 10 million Americans are still uninsured and over one-third of female voters report that they have had a hard time affording contraception at some point in their lives.

- But the current government has built an unfair economy where those at the top gain while those at the bottom suffer.
