Application requirements

To be eligible for the Raymond & Rhonda Wilson Scholarship Fund, you ***must be a graduating high school senior accepted/enrolled at a Historically Black College and University (HBCU), college sophomore or senior enrolled at a HBCU and demonstrate a strong commitment to improving the quality of life for people in your school, community and /or world at large through your community service.***

Applicants ***must also:***

- Submit a one page essay that describes who you are, what you have done to improve the quality of life for people in your community through your current community service
- Have a minimum unweighted GPA of 3.25 or higher
- Be a full-time undergraduate school student
- Submit current transcript (unofficial is acceptable)
- Include two references (one must be from a school counselor, teacher or professor)

The RRWSF Board selects the winners, who are notified in ***April.***
