Adultery

This is a popular sport in America right now, and the many who are attending this sporting event have no clue to the seriousness of it, like how can anything that seems so right be so wrong. If people bothered to find out how God thinks about it, they would avoid, resist, desist, and run for dear life. If your parents never had a talk with you, adultery is sexual intercourse between a married man and someone other than his wife, or between a married woman and someone other than her husband.

God considers sexual sins very binding, and the judgments are clearly written in the Word, but many in this world never read a Bible, or believe it if they do. It would be wonderful if we could write a Bible verse up in the sky in huge letters for the whole world to read every morning to be reminded, like *Don't commit adultery today, don't fornicate today, God is watching and judgment is coming*. You'd think everyone would obey then, but many would stop looking up to remind themselves of the consequences.

After reading the following verses, we can't say we haven't been warned. It is more binding than you may have thought, which is bad news for a lot of people. The good news is you can be delivered and forgiven through Christ, but the penalty of judgment will have to be worked out of your life, which it will be as your faith grows to be delivered.

“The man who commits **adultery** with another’s wife, even his neighbor’s wife, the adulterer and the adulteress shall surely be put to death.” (Lev. 20:10)

“For **adultery** is a heinous and chief crime, an iniquity to demand action by the judges and punishment. For uncontrolled passion is a fire which consumes to Abaddon, to destruction, ruin, and the place of final torment: that fire once lighted would rage until all is consumed and would burn to the root all my life’s increase.” (Job 31:11-12)

That is more descriptive than a
Hollywood writer could say.

“If a man is found lying with another man’s wife, **they shall both die**, the man who lay with the woman, and the woman: so shall you purge the evil from Israel.” (Deut. 22:22)

Try not to think of all the evil in this wonderful land of America. Let's try to purge it by knowledge and deliverance.

“If a maiden who is a virgin is engaged to be married, and a man finds her in the city and lies with her, then you shall bring them both out to the gate of the city and shall stone them to death, the young woman because she did not cry for help though she was in the city, and the man because he has violated his neighbor's promised wife. So shall you put away evil from among you.

“But if a man finds the betrothed maiden in the open country and the man seizes her and lies with her, then only the man who lay with her shall die. But you shall do nothing to the young woman: she has committed no sin punishable by death, for this is as when a man attacks and slays his neighbor. For he

came upon her in the open country, and the betrothed girl cried out, but there was no one to save her.

“If a man finds a girl who is a virgin, who is not betrothed, and he seizes her and lies with her and they are found, then the man who lay with her shall give to the girl’s father fifty shekels of silver, and she shall be his wife, because he has violated her: he may not divorce her all his days.

“A man shall not take his father’s former wife, nor shall he uncover her who belongs to his father.” (Deut. 22:23-30)

Spiritual Adultery

There is also **spiritual adultery**. The Lord says in Jeremiah 9:2:

“Oh, that I had in the wilderness a lodging place, a mere shelter, for wayfaring men, that I might leave my people and go away from them! For they are all adulterers, rendering worship to idols instead of to the Lord, Who has espoused the people to Himself; they are a gang of treacherous men, faithless even to each other.”

And Jeremiah 23:10:

“For the land is full of **adulterers**, forsakers of God, Israel’s true Husband. Because of the **curse** of God upon it the land mourns, the pastures of the wilderness are dried up.”

And James 4:4:

“You are like unfaithful wives having illicit love affairs with the world and breaking your marriage vow to God! Do you not know that being the world’s friend is being God’s enemy? Whoever chooses to be a friend of the world takes his stand as an enemy of God.”

And Isaiah 57:7-8:

“Upon a lofty and high mountain you have openly and shamelessly set your adulterous bed: even there you went up to **offer sac-**

rifices in spiritual unfaithfulness to your divine Husband. Behind the door and the doorpost *you have set up your idol symbol, as a substitute for the Scripture text God ordered.* Deserting Me, you have uncovered and enlarged your bed: and you have made a fresh bargain for yourself with the adulterers, and **you loved their bed, where you saw a beckoning hand or a passion-inflaming image.”**

More Adultery

God understands passion, He gave it to us in our makeup, and what He gave us He will help us to use in restraint. So if you see or feel that beckoning hand of passion in your workplace, in places you go, and even in church, run back home to your mate and hide for a while until your spiritual passions and not your fleshly passions are ruling. Unrestrained passion is one of the greatest, most common, easiest form of destruction that Satan brings upon mankind, saint or sinner alike.

“They are all **adulterers**: their passion smolders like heat of an oven when the baker ceases to stir the fire from the kneading of the dough until it is leavened.” (Hos. 7:4)

“Then I will draw near to you for judgment: I will be a swift witness against the sorcerers, against the **adulterers**, against the false swearers.” (Mal. 3:5)

“Do you not know that the unrighteous and the wrongdoers will not inherit or have any share in the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived, neither the impure and immoral, nor idolaters, nor **adulterers**, nor those who participate in homosexuality.” (1 Cor. 6:9)

“Let marriage be held in honor, esteemed worthy, precious, of great pride, and especially dear, in all things. And thus let the marriage bed be undefiled, for God will judge and punish the unchaste, all guilty of sexual vice and **adulterers.**” (Heb. 13:4)

If you have the judgment of adultery against you, or fornication, you may want to confess to a spiritual person and have the power of the Word broken off of your life. It seems we spend half our life getting into consequences that we weren't even aware of the darkness of them, and the other half trying to get out from under those consequences.

As deliverance people say constantly, our sins not only bring a judgment and hindrance against our lives and the lives of our families, but a spirit of darkness of some kind is happy to come in with the opening.

“I have seen your detestable acts, even your **adulteries** and your lustful neighings.” (Jer. 13:27)

“Lustful neighings.” Don’t you love the way God expresses Himself? I think we’ve all heard some neighings in our time, but weren’t as descriptive about it.

“For out of the heart come evil thoughts, such as murder, **adultery**, sexual vice, theft, false witnessing, slander, and irreverent speech. These are what make a man unclean and defile him.” (Mt. 15:19-20)

“This is the way of an **adulterous woman**: she eats and wipes her mouth and says, I have done no wickedness.” (Prov. 30:20)

“You shall not commit **adultery**.” (Ex. 20:14)

“They have eyes **full of adultery.**” (2 Pet. 2:14)

“Discretion shall watch over you, understanding shall keep you, to deliver you from the alien woman with her flattering words. Who forsakes the husband and guide of her youth and forgets the covenant of her God. For her house sinks down to death and her paths to the spirits of the dead.” (Prov. 2:16-18)

“For the commandment is a lamp, and the whole teaching of the law is light, and reproofs of discipline are the way of life. To keep you from the evil woman, from the flattery of the tongue of a loose woman. Lust not after her beauty in your heart, neither let her capture you with her eyelids. For on account of a harlot a man is brought to a piece of bread, and the **adulteress** stalks

and snares as with a hook the precious life of a man. Can a man take fire in his bosom and his clothes not be burned? Can one go upon hot coals and his feet not be burned? So he who cohabits with his neighbor's wife will be tortured with evil consequences and just retribution: he who touches her shall not be innocent or go unpunished." (Prov. 6:23-29)

"Whoever commits **adultery** with a woman lacks heart and understanding, moral principle and prudence: *he who does it is destroying his own life*. Wounds and disgrace will he get, and his reproach will not be wiped away. For jealousy makes the wronged man furious." (Prov. 6:32-34)

Divorce

“For the woman which hath an husband is bound by the law to her husband so long as he liveth; but if the husband be dead, she is loosed from the law of her husband. So then if, while her husband lives she is married to another man she shall be called an adulteress: but if her husband be dead, she is free from that law; so that she is no adulteress, though she be married to another man. Therefore, my brethren, you also are become dead to the law by the body of Christ; that you should be married to another, even to him who is raised from the dead, that we should bring forth fruit unto God.” (Romans 7:2-4)

The law makes us realize our sin, but Christ has died for our sins and we are married to Him, who is Life, and not to the law. If you were married and

divorced, the greater law is that you're married to Christ, and you're not an adulteress if you've confessed and repented (unless it was all your mate's fault!). The church used to shun divorced people and they couldn't hold an office in the church, like it was the unforgiveable sin, while the condemners are walking around in pride and gossip. The only one condemning divorced people is Satan, not God. Get your judging right. Also divorce before becoming a Christian or after may have different connotations and judgments.

Knowing how God feels about divorce, though, should encourage couples to speak to the mountains of troubles, confusion, and misunderstanding in marriage and sweat it through until you get on the other side of the problems and you've stayed together by God's grace and for the kids and your whole family lineage.

The Downfall of a Young Man

The downfall of a young man in Proverbs 7:3-23 (this could apply to the enticements of other sins also; read the whole story in the amplified Bible):

“Say to skillful and godly Wisdom, You are my sister, and regard understanding or insight as your intimate friend. That they may keep you from the loose woman, from the adventuress who flatters with and makes smooth her words.

“For at the window of my house I looked out through my lattice. And among the simple, empty headed and empty hearted ones, I perceived among the youths a young man void of good sense.

“Sauntering through the street near the loose woman’s corner: and he went the way to her house. In the twilight, in the evening, night black and dense was falling over the young man’s life.

“And behold, there met him a woman, dressed as a harlot and sly and cunning of heart. She is turbulent and willful; her feet stay not in her house. Now in the streets, now in the marketplaces, (or even in churches or places of business), she sets her ambush at every corner.”

(Remember, men, ambushes come in all forms, like batting eyelids.)

The enticement of sin continues, and down down down he goes:

“I sought your face and I have found you, I have spread my couch with rugs and cushions of tapestry, I have perfumed my bed with cinnamon, Come, let us take our fill of love until morning; let us console and delight ourselves with love.

“With much justifying and enticing argument she persuades him, with the allurements of her lips she leads him to overcome his conscience and his fears and forces him along.

“Suddenly he yields and follows her reluctantly like an ox moving to the slaughter...Till a dart of passion pierces and inflames his vitals; then like a bird fluttering straight into the net he hastens, not **knowing that it will cost him his life.**

“Let not your heart incline toward her ways, do not stray into her paths. **For she has cast down many wounded; her house is the way to Sheol going down to the chambers of death.**”

Wouldn't you love (maybe) to hear sermons from the pulpit on sexual subjects—because of the commonness of men to fall into these pits—that were preached with the same intensity and language that God uses. We need fire in the pulpit on this subject to counteract our liberal, misinformed, oversexed population.

There are other verses also warning of the consequences of sexual looseness. Let's throw in a scripture on **drinking** alcoholic beverages, as having a high old time can sometimes lead to adultery and fornication.

“Who has woe? Who has sorrow? Who has strife? Who has complaining? Who has wounds without cause? Who has redness and dimness of eyes? Those who tarry long at the wine, those who go to seek and try mixed wine. Do not look at wine when it is red, when it sparkles in the wineglass, when it goes down smoothly. At the last it **bites** like a serpent and **stings** like an adder. Under the **influence of wine your eyes will behold strange things and loose women** and your mind will utter things turned the wrong way, untrue, incorrect, and petulant. Yes, you will be as **unsteady** as he who lies down in the midst of the sea, and as **open to disaster** as he who lies upon the top of a mast. You will say, They struck me, but I was not hurt! They beat me as with a hammer, but I did not feel it! When shall I awake? I will **crave** and seek more wine again and **escape reality.**” (Prov. 23:29-35)

Fornication

Fornication is another popular devastating sporting event in our country and way beyond. It's been around for ages in all cultures, from the paupers to the princes. Many brag about their conquests, not realizing what they're bringing upon their own sexy selves and those they've "conquered." Satan is so deceiving. As if you didn't know, fornication is bedding down with someone other than between a man and his wife; between a spouse and an unmarried person, or intercourse between unmarried people. It says to "flee youthful lusts," in other words

be mature about your sexual life and make the right decisions to stay alive.

Any age can have youthful lusts, it's not just reserved for young people. I've heard about all the Romeos in the senior centers, which makes you smile in some ways, but it isn't going to help them eternally at the end of their life. God doesn't condone 90 year olds hopping into other old women's beds either; His laws of cleanness are for everyone. Free meals for seniors is one thing; free sex is another.

1 Corinthians 5:11:

“I write to you not to associate with anyone who bears the name of Christian brother if he is a **fornicator**. No, you must not so much as eat with such a person.”

This may cut down on your dinner companions but it's the Word. The church used to be much stronger on teaching separation from those who do evil. You love them and teach them, but if there's no turning you separate, not even getting a Big Mac together.

1 Thessalonians 4:3-4:

“For this is the will of God, that you should be separated and set apart for pure and holy living; that you should **abstain and shrink from all sexual vice**, that each one of you *should know how to control his own body* in purity. Not to be used in the passion of lust like the heathen, who are ignorant of the true God and have no knowledge of His will.”

Colossians 3:5:

“So kill, deaden, deprive of power the evil desire lurking in your members, those animal impulses and all that is earthly in you that is employed in sex: sexual vice, impurity, sensual appetites, unholy desires.”

Ephesians 5:3:

“But immorality and all impurity, of lustful, wasteful living, must not even be named among you, as is proper among God’s consecrated people.”

In 1 Corinthians 5:1-5 Paul writes to this church and says he hears there is sexual immorality among them, which is condemned, that a man has his own father’s wife. This is also in Deut. 22:30; 27:20. He goes on to say that this shameful thing must be removed from your fellowship. So Paul passes judg-

ment and says he is in that church in spirit and that in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ that man be delivered over to Satan for physical discipline to destroy carnal lusts which prompted him to incest, that his spirit may yet be saved in the day of the Lord Jesus. You can think about this one.

In 2 Corinthians 12:21 Paul said when he comes to see them again he will “bemoan many which have sinned and not repented of the **fornication** which they have committed.” It sounds like fornication is worthy of bewails.

1 Corinthians 10:5-13 Paul is relating to the church to learn from what happened to the Israelites in the Old Testament when 23,000 (yes!) were overthrown in the wilderness because they were **fornicators** and idolaters. Actually it says they were “strewn down along the ground in the wilderness.” Being strewn on the ground is not a picture you want in your family albums. Wouldn't that be in-

structive, to have pictures of Uncle Harry or Aunt Bertha, suffering from the throes of their sexual sins, Harry strewn in his backyard lawn and Bertha gasping for breath in her flower garden.

1 Corinthians 7, Paul says (he talks a lot about sex to the Corinthian church), that “because of the temptation to impurity and to avoid immorality, let each man have his own wife and let each woman have her own husband.” Good reason to get married. Satan fights marriage hard because the more our land gets filled with sexual immorality the more we become a heathen nation, follow after him, and come under God’s judgment.

Knowing these truths will help you to keep the standards of God for yourself, your family, and others because you’ll be able to admonish them and pray for them, while going over the family albums with them.

1 Corinthians 6:13, an interesting verse: “Food is intended for the stomach and the stomach for food, but God will finally end the functions of both and bring them to nothing. **The body is not intended for sexual immorality but is intended for the Lord**, and the Lord is intended for the body, to save and raise it again.”

Face all of the Bible facts concerning sex, and on a scale of 1 to 10 judge yourself until you're a 10 instead of a 1½. Paul continues with his facts of life exhortation: “Shun immorality and all sexual looseness, flee from impurity in thought, word, or deed. Any other sin which a man commits is one outside the body, *but he who commits sexual immorality sins against his own body.*”

“But I use protection to avoid pregnancy and we're going to eventually get married, we can't afford it right now and we want a huge wedding, and if you

love each other what's the difference?" Rubbers will not protect your soul. (Did she really say that? Yes, she did.) Love will not even protect your soul because the judgments of the Word endure forever unless broken off. And did anyone in your life ever tell you that if you enter into pornography (which will become addictive) spirits of all kinds will start swarming all over you, above you, and eventually in you, so unless you want a spirit of lust and perversion and child molestation and debauchery in your life, don't touch or watch the unclean. Your dad probably warned you that hard-core porn brings hard-core judgments with it. If he didn't, ask him why not.

It sounds perfectly reasonable that our God would exhort us to be pure because our bodies are the temple of His Holy Spirit. We gasp, oh Christians couldn't have a demon, and yet we house and nurture all kinds of sexual impurities without a gasp, and even with excuses. There's that casualness again!

Masturbation

This is the M word. The act of masturbation is making love to yourself, finding satisfaction in yourself outside of marriage, enticing yourself, and showing no restraint to gratification. All of these feelings that God created are for the union and within the confines of marriage. People aren't taught how God feels about sexual conduct outside of marriage. Many doctors, counselors, and writers encourage masturbation, saying it's natural, good for stress, and run in the bathroom whenever you feel like it. That is natural man's thinking, and not God's. Many get so

hooked on this constant self-gratification and can't/won't stop, like smoking or drugs.

God's presence is in bathrooms as well as churches, and His supernatural video camera is clicking over us day and night. "That which is done in secret will be shouted upon the housetops," (Lk. 12:3). Would you want a picture in your family album of you taking drugs, watching pornography, or masturbating? God will have every click of everything you've done in your life that is not confessed and turned from in His Family Album. Let's add that everyone in the world will be looking at the Family of God Album.

One reason there is no restraint is that people aren't taught of consequences, even though there may have been vague comments against it from parents or church leaders. With all the sexual pictures, talk, unclean movies, and looseness in the

world and TV concerning sex, it takes a firm daily choice to keep your heart and mind pure, but there again, we can choose to walk in the Spirit and not the flesh. Your own conscience will convict you of this. As this book points out, what you do can easily have a spirit come right behind the act and join your life, and it has a right because of your invitation of disobedience to God's laws of cleanness. And of course you can invite a spirit of Masturbation into your life.

Leviticus chapters 18 and 20 are "sex" chapters, and you'll learn a lot from them that you won't read in our liberal society. In Lev. 15:32, the Lord is talking about those who have unclean discharges, and says, "This is the law for him who has a discharge and for him who has *emissions of sperm, being made unclean by it.*"

Deuteronomy 23:9-10 states, “When you are encamped against your enemies, be careful to avoid anything offensive. If there is a man among you who is unclean because of a bodily emission during the night, he must go outside the camp; he may not come anywhere inside the camp. When evening approaches, he must wash with water, and when the sun sets he may come inside the camp.”

Homosexuality

As if you didn't know, it's a man having sex with a man and a woman having sex with another woman. You can sin against your body by fornication, against your body and family with adultery, but God gave us the following exhortation concerning homosexuality. The reason we asked Him was because some we talked to were saying that homosexuality is no worse than all the misery divorce causes, what's the difference?

“And the Lord says to you that you need to understand so that you can tell others the danger in this and why it is so evil is because it goes against the very nature of that which the Lord has established. And the Lord says that God created man and woman and He created so that you could reproduce, but this is **insidious** in that it goes against the very nature of the Lord. And the Lord hates all sin, and all sin brings forth death, but this, as the Lord says, goes against that which God created, the very nature of man and woman.”

Judge from the Bible, and what happened to the cities of Sodom and Gomorrah (where huge hail stones from God’s rock quarry came pounding down on all the wild sex-crazy citizens). And the city of Gibeah where almost the whole tribe of Benjamin was wiped out because they stood up

for homosexuality and wouldn't punish those that participated in it. God said this sin defiled the whole land with perversion.

The Bible—that we as Christians swear by—says concerning homosexuality:

“If a man also lies with a male as if he were a woman, both of them have committed an abomination: they shall surely be put to death; their blood shall be upon them.”
(Lev. 20:13)

“You shall not lie with a man as with a woman; it is an abomination.” (Lev. 18:22)

“And there were also **sodomites** in the land; and they did according to all the abominations of the nations which the Lord cast out before the people of Israel.”
(1 Ki. 14:24)

Let's add another abomination: unless your soul has dried up you probably recognize the following as a beastly sin: "Neither shall you lie with any beast and defile yourself with it; neither shall any woman yield herself to a beast to lie with it: it is confusion, perversion, and degradedly carnal." (Lev. 28:23)

"Do not defile yourselves in any of these ways, for in all these things the nations are defiled which I am casting out before you. And the land is defiled; therefore I visit the iniquity of it upon it, and the land itself *vomits out its inhabitants.*" (Lev. 28:24-25)

The New Testament pronounces in Romans 1:26-28 and is blazingly clear, no excuses:

"God gave some over and abandoned them to vile affections and degrading passions. For their women exchanged their natural

function for an unnatural and abnormal one. **And the men also turned from natural relations with women and were set ablaze with lust for one another—men committing shameful acts with men,** and suffering in their own bodies and personalities the inevitable consequences and penalty of their wrongdoing and going astray.”

Jude 7 in the New Testament is also clear:

“The wicked are sentenced to suffer just as Sodom and Gomorrah and the adjacent towns—which likewise gave themselves over to impurity and indulged in unnatural vice and sensual perversity—*are laid out in plain sight as an exhibit* of perpetual punishment to warn of everlasting fire.” (Jude 7)

God and Abraham are talking in Genesis, and God is explaining why He was going to destroy

Sodom and Gomorrah. Genesis 18:20-21, “And the Lord said, Because the *shriek of the sins of Sodom and Gomorrah is great and their sins exceedingly grievous*. I will go down now and see whether they have done altogether as *vilely and wickedly as is the cry of it which has come to Me*; and if not, I will know.”

God loves homosexuals and wants them to know Him, but He hates homosexuality (as He does all sin). It defiles our bodies and the land we live in. We sing that our country is the “land of the free and the home of the brave.” If you think you’re free enough and brave enough to get by with homosexuality, you are bound and ignorant. And don’t get defensive, we love you, and we preach against all sin, but homosexuality is definitely a big curse against our land. And marching in a gay pride parade with banners and balloons doesn’t change God’s thinking one bit.

The strongest argument for homosexuality is that people are born that way. You can be born with tendencies because it has been in your family somewhere and the sins and iniquities of the parents are passed down, so there could be weaknesses this way. But think about it, many people are born with anger for instance, and they have to strive to get rid of it because they know it's not right. You can't say I was born angry so I have to stay angry all my life. No, get the weakness healed so it's not in you any more. There is not a gay gene, meaning you never can change. That is a lie of the devil. Any sin can be changed by letting God work in your life. And if God condemns homosexuality, why would He have His beloved creation born that way to live in condemnation for eternity?

Just because a strong lustful burning is there doesn't make it right, like how can something so strong be so wrong; it just means Satan is fighting for your soul. Let the fire of God burn out

all that stuff. It may take a while and it may take some fighting it, but through Christ you can do all things. God says if any part of your body causes you to sin, cut it off. (Sorry men.)

When you pray for people let them know the sin of these sexual perversions, and pray for their soul and mind and spirit to be cleansed. Many times there is a spirit of Fornication operating in them too because they have left their life open to it, or a spirit of Homosexuality, an unclean spirit, and many other spirits which the Lord will help you to know. What they have been involved in needs to be confessed, not sordid detail, but enough to say this or that was a sin and I confess it, and it does make a difference if it was one time or the whole pattern of a lifetime.

Homosexuals can be overbearing and extravagant in their dress and manners to prove they're a woman or a man when they're obviously not. The Lord says it's confusion. God has given us many

obvious signs on what's what in His creation: two good signs are breasts on a woman, and one good sign for a man is obvious. When you deal with a homosexual a legion can be there. They can be very religious. They are very bold when they come out of the closet (those closets need a thorough Spirit cleaning), and the strong spirit of Homosexuality is slowly creeping into our society until it is more accepted; and now if you say anything against it, you have to appear on Larry King Live and renounce what you said, say you're sorry and sob.

I've known, loved, and prayed for lesbians and homosexuals, and am friendly with many. So I'm not picking out a certain sin. We're also mindful of the seven things God hates, (which most of us have participated in). These are written in Proverbs 6:16-19, but right now we'll stick to the subject of bad sex stuff.

Even 'Things' Have Mates

A senior friend of mine named Linda reminded me of a truth about mating that I'll include here.

Most every man and many women who work with tools, like plumbers, woodworkers, mechanics, engineers, electricians, etc. know that some tools come in pairs. One part is called the “male,” the other the “female.” You can't have a perfect complete connection without both parts. They are also called “the in and the out.”

Two “males” don’t work to make a connection, nor do two “females,” two “ins” or two “outs.” You need a set, one male and one female to get the job done. Some of them snap together, slide together or screw (pardon the expression) together, and they have to fit perfectly.

In creation when God was making all this wonderful stuff we’re surrounded with, and I won’t quote all the verses here (look it up for yourself), every living creature was told to “Be fruitful and multiply,” including mankind of course. You’ll notice after the verses it also says that “God saw that it was **good.**” He likes the way He did it in the beginning and He’s never given a hint that you can change that plan by your own personal desires.

All that busy multiplying is done by male and female parts. Two male parakeets can’t lay an egg and multiply; two female horses can’t produce a foal. Even plants need a male part to fertilize the

female part to reproduce a flower and produce more seed. It's more productive in the natural and a lot more saving in the spiritual to side with God on this one. (Gen. 1:20-22; 1:24-25; 1:29-30; 1:26-27; 1:28.) God gives us many things in the natural to help us understand the spiritual.

Child Molestation

Parents: I double warn you to be very watchful, careful, and wise in who you leave your precious children with. Most children are molested by family friends, relatives, and brothers. We are concerned about the guy lurking around at the park, and let our guard down around relatives that we love and trust. Because of the prevalence of men sexually abusing children, I would not leave my child with anyone with a penis unless I had the assurance from the Lord that it would be safe for my child.

The world is filled with lustful, sexual images, billboards, magazines, nakedness, movies and books, not to mention porn and child porn on home computers. Add a lack of moral compass to a man, and you can see why men would be tempted to “play around” and molest. The seeds of sex have already been put in his mind and heart.

We know that women can be molesters too, but it's rare compared to men, so we'll concentrate on the man molesters here. I have prayed with people for years and you would be shocked to know how many children have been molested and even raped by their brothers. They are threatened not to tell, and if they do, parents turn a blind eye and say, Oh my kid would never do that. Or the parents don't want to face it and deal with it, so little girls are open season to the sex drive in the male.

It's not that grandpa Fred says or thinks when he gets up in the morning, oh I think I'll molest my grandchild today (then again, maybe he does!), but as he has the physical contact, the girl is sitting on his lap...the sexual desires rise up if the man hasn't been trained to keep them under control or is an unclean person sexually from his past or watching pornography.

Molestation strips away children's innocence, leaves a darkness on them, and well you've read all the sad stories from older woman who finally come out and confess what's been done to them when young by dads, stepdads, friends, and relatives. They carry a shame and guilt that they can't express, and their emotions are involved, not just the physical.

Don't be naïve about this. Women who work and raise kids are very busy and don't have access to

moms and sisters to babysit so take whoever is available. So it's hard on women to cover all their bases for their children. But somehow it has to be done because of the lifelong problems for little children who can't even express what's been done to them and have to carry that darkness the rest of their lives until healed.

Molestation can be sneaky and fast and even while parents are in the house, and the child and male are in another room. So don't think because you're around your child is safe. Children have to be protected and guarded because of their vulnerability.

Please don't think your family is different or would never do such a thing. Your child is first priority in your life. And, like I say, you'd be shocked at the commonness of it, and all the counselors I talk to say the same thing: it's a plague from so-called innocent directions.

Parenting is a demanding job and you like a respite to shop, or go out, but make sure your child is safe. The danger is real and can't be downplayed or pushed aside.

Uncleanness

Many dangerous sexual practices could be listed under the title “uncleanness,” a serious offense in God’s eyes. The words “unclean,” and “uncleanness” are mentioned at least 215 times in the Bible. It’s not a passive, vague thing that you can ignore, because God is very clear you’re not sitting at the marriage supper of the Lamb if you are practicing uncleanness and haven’t repented of it.

Young people particularly are not clear on this subject as there are many “things” going on amongst

them like oral sex, anal sex, getting each other satisfied in various ways, even boys with boys who don't claim to be homosexuals, and in general many perverted acts. But the thinking is well there was no actual sex, the hymen wasn't broken. Hymen, stymen, God hates it because it will destroy your life.

In fact, listen to Him speaking to us:

“For be sure of this: that no person practicing sexual vice or impurity in thought or in life...has any inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and of God.

“Let no one delude and deceive you with empty excuses and groundless arguments for these sins, for through these things the wrath of God comes upon the sons of rebellion and disobedience.” (Ephesians 5:5-6)

Any sexual activity outside of marriage is considered a sin by God's Word.

Then there's the famous old-time church verse:

“What agreement has the temple of God with idols? For you are the temple of the living God; as God has said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people.

“Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you.”

(2 Cor. 6:16-18)

When sexual desires are so strong this may seem unreasonable or unattainable, but hard decisions have to be made and lived by if we want to spend eternity with a Holy God. Part of the reason living a clean sexual life seems hard is because we've lured ourselves by all the unclean stuff around us, and sexual innuendoes are everywhere, on posters, shopping bags, store fronts, advertisements,

and unclean “comedies.” You may have to blind-fold yourself to avoid temptation. Resist, resist, resist!!! “Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world” is God’s cry to us, if we want to be part of His kingdom world.

Abortion: There is no chapter on abortion because it’s obvious it is taking a life (which can be forgiven). I’ll just say this one thing that still haunts me when I think about it. When someone is trying to kill a baby in the womb, that baby fights with all its little might to live, and struggles against death just like you or I would do if someone was trying to kill us. There is pain and panic. That desire to live was put there by God the Creator. When I think of a baby fighting and gasping to live inside the womb, not wanting to give in to the death being imposed upon it, I cry.

Wedlock: Having a child out of wedlock (a common, every day thing I know), binds that child until that sin is confessed, and prayer is made to get them re-

leased from the judgment of it (scripture calls them “bastards”). I tell you folks, we mess around with all this sex stuff, making and killing babies, or spilling the little things out to join our unmarried loose life; and then wonder what to do with them, even considering them a big inconvenience. And we question why our life and the lives of our children are such a mess. It’s extremely true that “God’s thoughts are not our thoughts, and His ways are not our ways” (Isa. 55:8-9). We might add that His thoughts of a sex life are not our thoughts of a sex life.

Seniors, whether at home or in assisted living centers, receive mail constantly on things to order to have solo sex. There is much texting going on, among young people particularly, showing their body parts....how about doing your homework, helping at home and going to church instead? We are bombarded hourly with perverseness, debauchery (look it up), and sexual images that are outside of God’s boundaries.

“As a man thinks in his heart so he is” (Prov. 23:7). So when unclean thoughts come, rebuke them!! Cast those thoughts down to the ground instead of inviting them into your mind and heart. And don’t get on the internet for a few “looks” to stimulate yourself, and then feel guilty (maybe) for masturbating. Let’s get the fear of the Lord going on in us, and desire and love holiness so we can be close to God. Remember this: *If you will train yourself and keep your mind clean, your genitals will follow* (be sure and tell your friends this)!

Confession: Many of you who read this book probably imagine that this little old senior typing out all these rules and regulations, walking the strait and narrow way, is because she (me) is out of it and/or inexperienced. But in my prehistoric days I was married and getting a divorce, engaged to a basketball star, and dating my now husband, all at the same time, plus taking care of a baby, working at Boeing, and inhaling smoke. This took

some maneuvering, but obviously I wasn't a godly person. Dancing and running around was my passion and the love of my life.

But as time went on I was hungry for something more, afraid I was going to die, and started seeking God. I wisely decided that God had far more benefits than my present choices. So, give up all the junk and wrong living and start dating and running around with God. It's worth it. It took me years of deliverance to get rid of all the bad sex stuff and bindings so I know what I'm chirping about. Because I gave up that self-serving life, that baby, and all my babies (some seniors now), are all serving God. Save yourself some trouble and get your life, sex included, clean and happy.

Pray & Decree

Let's do the world a big favor and start praying against all this uncleanness. You and I can make many decrees (Job 22:28) to help change God's

people involved in sexual impurity.

We decree: That the stronghold of sexual sin in America is being broken, including sex outside of marriage, homosexuality, incest, and pornography. We decree that in its place will come a revival of purity and holiness. That the 3-fold cord of drugs, alcohol, and sex is broken off our youth.

We decree that the sin of covenant-breaking, manifesting through divorce, generational breaches, disloyalty, racial strife, lying, disrespect of authority and broken relationships in general is now being broken in America. We decree that in its place covenant faithfulness will once again prevail.

So, we judge the sin, not the sinner, and believe that prayer changes bad sex things. So let's pray and decree for ourselves, our kids, and our nation.

Bedding Down Outside the Marriage Bed

Some absent-minded people forget where their own bed is, or their marriage bed, and start sleeping around. So when they find a bed that has a bed partner in it, sexual intercourse is the natural development. What they didn't learn in their birds and bees class was that when they got up from the mattress they had invited any darkness that was against their partner to become a partner with them.

And you thought you got by with it didn't you? But when you have intercourse with a person outside of marriage you become one with them, and you are open to their infirmities, weaknesses, and bindings from their family. Oh-oh. This is serious stuff. If you have had relations outside of marriage and you live to be a senior, you can start feeling the infirmities of those you've been one with even years before as you became one in God's eyes and in the eyes of darkness. Even a hobbling around senior can have a spry background with many spry partners, and they need to be delivered from what spryness did to them. And if that past partner in crime dies before you do, you are more open to death then and to the spirits that would leave their soul at death.

For your information, there can be a transference of spirits through generations in your blood line, and spirits transferred to you through your associations, especially if you've bit the bed with them.

Some call it ungodly soul ties. When a person dies the spirits they have can go into someone else, especially a family member. As soon as a family member dies you should ask God for deliverance from their spirits for you and your family.

God said, “There has no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that which you are able to endure; but will *with the temptation make a way to escape, that you may be able to bear it,*” (1 Cor. 10:13). So scream and run if you have to, that may be your escape route.

Much demonic power can enter in through wrongful sexual relations and start controlling every loose life, and spirits of infirmity can enter in and bring a harvest of physical ailments.

Paul warned the Corinthians if they had sex with prostitutes, for example, then they became one flesh together. In the act of ungodly intercourse the demonic has free access to transfer between the partners, so people will pick up demons of all types from their sexual partners. The spirits are not prevented from entering a believer in that sort of situation and they will walk across the welcome mat to whoever puts it down, be it sinner, a Christian, a Buddhist, New Ager, Atheist, or Charismatic.

The Lord has told us when we pray for those who are older to pray against the spirit of Infirmities and the spirit of Death that may be over them or in them because someone they were one with in the past has since deceased. After they've confessed, pray for this sin of the soul, then for any spirits. That frivolous expression, to "hop in the sack," if it's with the wrong person, can put you in a sack in more ways than one.

If you have many partners your soul is spread out all over the place. Ask God to bring back to the individual every part of him that has been attached to the different partners involved. In other words, your soul and feelings need to be gathered together and brought back to you.

I can see many of you running for a prayer partner, confessing your past indiscretions (to put it mildly), and asking for deliverance. Good for you. Keep at it.

Bless your heart (and soul and mind) for reading this booklet. Now let's clean up our act(s), get healed of bad sex stuff, and have God create a clean heart and mind in us (He's good at that!). The Word says, "Blessed are the pure in heart for they shall see God," and I don't want to miss seeing God for eternity.
