Grant Spotlight

High Altitude Balloon Launch

Science Teachers Laura Kuchenmeister and Becky Stark from Hidden Oaks Middle School were recently awarded this grant.

A recent LEF approved grant, "High Altitude Balloon Launch was awarded to middle school students at Hidden Oaks Middle School. The purpose of the grant was for the science class to launch a high altitude balloon from the campus this past spring. The balloon was equipped with photo, GPS and data collection equipment. This allowed students to engage in real-world STEM data collection and observation.

Students affectionately named it Peppa Pig. Peppa is back from the balloon adventure. The balloon reached a peak altitude of over 80,000 feet and ended up in Stanley Wisconsin. Describing it does not do it justice! A video was provided that explains the adventure.


