## FEAST OF THE ASCENSION OF THE LORD

<u>CONTACTLESS COLLECTIONS</u> With the absence of banks in the village, and COVID risks of handling of money - we have joined the Diocese with the contactless donation system called DONA. <u>There is a Stand in the porch of Our Lady of</u> <u>Lourdes Church to receive Contactless Payments. Please use the hand sanitiser</u> <u>beforehand</u>. At first, indicate where your payment is to go e.g. (1<sup>st</sup> Collection or 2<sup>nd</sup> Collection) then select the amount you are donating. If you wish to Gift Aid your donation please follow the instructions – name, email & postcode. <u>You will only need to do this the first time you</u> <u>make a donation</u>. The system has been set up and will automatically deal with any subsequent donations.

**PLEASE BE AWARE ... Instructions for receiving Holy Communion during the Covid 19 Pandemic** People should wait in their pews until instructed to move forward to the Altar steps for Holy Communion by the Stewards. Communion must be given in silence, in the hand only, and avoiding any physical contact. The communicant should approach the Deacon/Priest with his/her arms outstretched to the full, palms facing upwards, one on top of the other, lying as flat as possible, **The communicant should then unloop his/her face covering and consume the Sacred Host at the sanctuary steps.** Then replacing their face covering he/she moves back to their pew via the side aisles.

<u>Upon entering the church before MASS OR PRIVATE PRAYER</u>, please sanitise your hands and either scan in on the NHS Track & Trace or tick your name off the register. Please take a small sheet of paper from the porch and leave it in the pew when you leave the church. This is to ensure all the appropriate areas in church get sanitised after every service. <u>At all times please adhere to the rules of SOCIAL DISTANCING</u> and the wearing of <u>FACE</u> MASKS. Please keep up to date by reading the newsletter.

**PRAYER MARATHON** On May 1<sup>st</sup>, Pope Francis launched a month-long prayer marathon to hasten the end of the coronavirus pandemic with a prayer at St Peter's Basilica. Every day for the rest of May, Catholic sanctuaries in the world dedicated to Mary will take turns holding a similar rosary service. The initiative will involve all the Shrines of the world, ranging from Fatima & Lourdes, to shrines in Poland, Nigeria, Cuba & South Korea as well as the Basilica of the Immaculate Conception in Washington, concluding with Pope Francis holding the final rosary recitation in the Vatican Gardens Chapel on 31<sup>st</sup> May with a specially-broadcast prayer. The Rosary, led from a different Marian Sanctuary each day during May, will be broadcast by Vatican Media, beginning at 6pm Rome time.
