Monoecious vs. Dioecious

In monoecious hemp varieties you will find the male and female plant parts on the same plant. However, hemp is naturally dioecious, meaning that monoecious varieties are actually a result of careful plant breeding in order to increase grain yield and produce higher quality fibre.

All monoecious varieties have a variety of plant types within the stand. The majority of the plants will be monoecious, that is, the male and female parts being on one plant. But it is a myth that 100% of the plant population in a monoecious variety will be of this type, as you will also find pure male and pure female plants too. Routinely, there is up to 10% pure males in a monoecious variety stand. Usually the number of males in a stand looks worse than it really is because the male plant's distinct characteristics make them stand out against the crowd.
