

Congratulations to **Brian Wright** for claiming the **April Monthly Medal** with **63 Nett,** including a birdie on the 10th.


Brian claimed the medal over Peter Nicholson, who also carded a 63 Nett via the countback method.

CLUBHOUSE UPDATE

with Paterson GC Committee

Throughout the April Saturday Competitions the clubhouse has been operated by either a committee members or has been closed during play to ensure food & beverage items are pre-purchased & are not paid for retrospectively where possible. Members & guests must purchase any food or beverages they wish to consume prior to their round which can be stored in the fridge located on the clubhouse verandah during play (until the clubhouse bar is opened by a committee member). The Members BBQ will continue to operate following play with Members reminded to be conscious of the amount of food they consume to ensure all players are catered for. The committee will continue to monitor & assess this process moving forward.

As mentioned earlier, the committee will also be discussing & determining our annual membership packages during our May meeting & distributing correspondence to returning members & commencing our advertising campaign for prospective members.

Whilst some elements of course maintenance will reduce in the cooler months, regular machinery works are being completed in addition to exploring options for a new ride-on mower unit which will assist with areas across the property particularly during wet periods.

UNDER PAR COUNT

Throughout the April Saturday Competitions 170 rounds were lodged, with players scoring a total of 78 birdies or better. We had a 5-way tie for the monthly tally with Benjamin Curry (8), Glenn Davies (4), Jordan Wilkinson (3), Paul Monaghan (7) & Max Wallington (+2) [Maitland] all sharing the lead with 5 birdies each, including an eagle for Benjamin.



The half yearly Eclectic Competition continues in the background of each weekly Open Competition. The Eclectic Competition is split into 2 Divisions with the respective winners & runner ups allocated a value to their prize account at the end of June & December.

The Eclectic Competition calculates the lowest score scored by each player in every round they participate in to calculate a cumulative best round throughout the period with your lowest handicap during the period being adjusted to 50% to determine a Nett score.
