
Dear Mr. President:

Attached is a Proclamation I signed as Governor of New Mexico on January 1, 2011 after I took my oath of office under Section 1, Article XX, New Mexico Constitution and presented my Recognizance Bond binding me to the oath I took. Unfortunately, I am unable to confirm my election to the Office of New Mexico Governor for lack of a competent court of law within the boundaries of New Mexico.

I brought this matter to your attention previously and was visited by two state police officers on the assumption I would use force to occupy that office. Although they would not reveal who informed them of the matter, they were satisfied that I would not. As the attached Proclamation reveals, there is an active insurrection against both constitutions by persons unlawfully holding public offices within New Mexico and at least six of the former insurgents hold federal commissions under false pretenses in the United States District Court for the District of New Mexico and the Court of Appeals for the Tenth Circuit, and I just happen to be the only lawful state public officer able to notify you of that fact. Those holding federal commissions under false pretenses can be charged with the same impeachable offence contained in Article IV of the Article of Impeachment for which the United States Senate in December 2010 found G. Thomas Porteous guilty. The Tenth Circuit Judicial Council has a current cause of action notifying them of that legal fact.

Please consider the attached Proclamation as an integral part of this letter notifying your office of the insurrection against both constitutions.
