

Clean Food (Kosher Food)

God's commandments and ordinances are for all true believers whether they were repented believing Jews or chosen converted Gentiles. Thus, these laws pertain to the true believers Christians as they are also commanded by the Apostles in Acts 15 below.

Four Definitions:

[1] Kosher means Clean Food according to YHWH God (not according to the rabbis).

[2] Abomination means stinking pollution.

[3] Kashrut Law is the Clean Food Law of God not of the rabbis.

[4] Breaking Kashrut Law is not a sin per se, but it is a pollution to the body.

Leviticus Chapter 11

1 Now the LORD spoke to Moses and Aaron, saying to them, 2 "Speak to the children of Israel, saying, 'These are the animals which you may eat among all the animals that are on the earth:	These are the Words of YHWH God and they are not Moses' or Aaron's laws or words They are not Mosaic Law, but God's Word.
3 Among the animals, whatever divides the hoof, having cloven hooves and chewing the cud--that you may eat.	Kosher (Clean) animals (1) Divide the hoof and (2) Chew the cud. (E.g., cows, sheep, goats.)

<p>4 Nevertheless these you shall not eat among those that chew the cud or those that have cloven hooves: the camel, because it chews the cud but does not have cloven hooves, is unclean to you;</p> <p>5 the rock hyrax, because it chews the cud but does not have cloven hooves, is unclean to you;</p> <p>6 the hare, because it chews the cud but does not have cloven hooves, is unclean to you;</p> <p>7 and the swine, though it divides the hoof, having cloven hooves, yet does not chew the cud, is unclean to you.</p> <p>8 Their flesh you shall not eat, and their carcasses you shall not touch. They are unclean to you.</p>	<p>Unclean animals do not chew the cud or do not have divided hoofs.</p> <p>(E.g., camels, horses, hyrax, hare, rabbits, pigs.)</p> <p>Unclean animals, if eaten, cause body pollution.</p> <p>The body is the temple of God. No one brings stinking filth and place it inside the temple of God.</p>
<p>9 'These you may eat of all that are in the water: whatever in the water has fins and scales, whether in the seas or in the rivers--that you may eat.</p>	<p>All fish which has both (1) Fins and (2) Scales, are clean.</p>
<p>10 But all in the seas or in the rivers that do not have fins and scales, all that move in the water or any living thing which is in the water, they are an abomination to you.</p> <p>11 They shall be an abomination to you; you shall not eat their flesh, but you shall regard their carcasses as an abomination.</p> <p>12 Whatever in the water does not have fins or scales--that shall be an abomination to you.</p>	<p>Unclean sea food is anything that does not have both fins and scales.</p> <p>(E.g., dolphins, whales, sharks, eels, lobsters, shrimp.)</p>

<p>13 'And these you shall regard as an abomination among the birds; they shall not be eaten, they are an abomination: the eagle, the vulture, the buzzard, 14 the kite, and the falcon after its kind; 15 every raven after its kind, 16 the ostrich, the short-eared owl, the sea gull, and the hawk after its kind; 17 the little owl, the fisher owl, and the screech owl; 18 the white owl, the jackdaw, and the carrion vulture; 19 the stork, the heron after its kind, the hoopoe, and the bat.</p>	<p>Unclean birds are mentioned as: Vultures, eagles, buzzards, hawks, falcons, kites, ostriches, owls, sea gulls, jackdaws, carrion vultures, stork, heron, hoopoe, bats.</p>
<p>20 'All flying insects that creep on all fours shall be an abomination to you.</p>	<p>All insects are unclean except two kinds mentioned below.</p>
<p>21 Yet these you may eat of every flying insect that creeps on all fours: those which have jointed legs above their feet with which to leap on the earth. 22 These you may eat: the locust after its kind, the destroying locust after its kind, the cricket after its kind, and the grasshopper after its kind. 23 But all other flying insects which have four feet shall be an abomination to you.</p>	<p>Clean insects have (1) jointed legs above their feet, and (2) do leap. (E.g., locusts, crickets, grasshoppers.)</p>

24 'By these you shall become unclean; whoever touches the carcass of any of them shall be unclean until evening;
25 whoever carries part of the carcass of any of them shall wash his clothes and be unclean until evening;
26 The carcass of any animal which divides the foot, but is not cloven-hoofed or does not chew the cud, is unclean to you. Everyone who touches it shall be unclean.
27 And whatever goes on its paws, among all kinds of animals that go on all fours, those are unclean to you. Whoever touches any such carcass shall be unclean until evening.
28 Whoever carries any such carcass shall wash his clothes and be unclean until evening. It is unclean to you.

29 'These also shall be unclean to you among the creeping things that creep on the earth: the mole, the mouse, and the large lizard after its kind;
30 the gecko, the monitor lizard, the sand reptile, the sand lizard, and the chameleon.
31 These are unclean to you among all that creep. Whoever touches them when they are dead shall be unclean until evening.

The Law regarding touching Unclean animals carcass:

Dead unclean animals cannot be touched, or else the person becomes unclean.

If anyone touches the carcass of an unclean animal becomes unclean until the evening and must wash his clothes.

Unclean animals (added list):

Geckos, lizards, sand reptiles, chameleons, and the likes reptiles.

<p>32 Anything on which any of them falls, when they are dead shall be unclean, whether it is any item of wood or clothing or skin or sack, whatever item it is, in which any work is done, it must be put in water. And it shall be unclean until evening; then it shall be clean.</p> <p>33 Any earthen vessel into which any of them falls you shall break; and whatever is in it shall be unclean:</p> <p>34 in such a vessel, any edible food upon which water falls becomes unclean, and any drink that may be drunk from it becomes unclean.</p> <p>35 And everything on which a part of any such carcass falls shall be unclean; whether it is an oven or cooking stove, it shall be broken down; for they are unclean, and shall be unclean to you.</p>	<p>If the carcass or body part of a dead unclean animal touches a vessel, such vessel becomes unclean until the evening and must be washed.</p> <p>If the vessel becomes unclean, the food therein becomes unclean.</p> <p>If the vessel contains dried food, such as uncooked rice or uncooked beans, then the dried food remains clean.</p> <p>If part of the carcass of the unclean animal falls on the stove or the oven, the stove or the oven becomes unclean and must be thoroughly washed before use.</p>
<p>36 Nevertheless a spring or a cistern, in which there is plenty of water, shall be clean, but whatever touches any such carcass becomes unclean.</p> <p>37 And if a part of any such carcass falls on any planting seed which is to be sown, it remains clean.</p> <p>38 But if water is put on the seed, and if a part of any such carcass falls on it, it becomes unclean to you.</p>	<p>If the dead carcass of unclean animal falls in a spring or a cistern, the water remains clean, but the person who touches the carcass remains unclean.</p> <p>If the dead carcass of unclean animal falls on dry seed, the dry seed remain clean.</p> <p>If the seed was wet or sprouting, then it become unclean and cannot be eaten.</p>
<p>39 'And if any animal which you may eat dies, he who touches its carcass shall be unclean until evening.</p> <p>40 He who eats of its carcass shall wash his clothes and be unclean until evening. He also who carries its carcass shall wash his clothes and be unclean until evening.</p>	<p>Touching the carcass of clean kosher animals makes the person unclean until the evening and he must wash his clothes.</p>

<p>41 'And every creeping thing that creeps on the earth shall be an abomination. It shall not be eaten.</p> <p>42 Whatever crawls on its belly, whatever goes on all fours, or whatever has many feet among all creeping things that creep on the earth--these you shall not eat, for they are an abomination.</p>	<p>All creepers are unclean.</p> <p>(E.g., snakes, worms.)</p>
<p>43 You shall not make yourselves abominable with any creeping thing that creeps; nor shall you make yourselves unclean with them, lest you be defiled by them.</p>	<p>Do NOT defile (make your body filthy) by eating unclean animals or creepers.</p>
<p>44 For I am the LORD your God. You shall therefore consecrate yourselves, and you shall be holy; for I am holy. Neither shall you defile yourselves with any creeping thing that creeps on the earth.</p> <p>45 For I am the LORD who brings you up out of the land of Egypt, to be your God. You shall therefore be holy, for I am holy.</p>	<p>YHWH God is holy and pure.</p> <p>All true believers purify themselves: spirit, heart, mind, and body.</p> <p>All true believers abstain from pollution of their spirit, mind, heart, and body.</p> <p>YHWH God redeemed us (from Egypt = slavery of sin) and saved us from Satan legal claim.</p> <p>All true believers must be HOLY as YHWH God is HOLY. Holy means separated from the filth in the world and maintaining purity and commitment to one God, YHWH.</p>
<p>46 'This is the law of the animals and the birds and every living creature that moves in the waters, and of every creature that creeps on the earth,</p> <p>47 to distinguish between the unclean and the clean, and between the animal that may be eaten and the animal that may not be eaten.' "</p>	<p>This is the law of food (Kashrut law).</p> <p>Breaking this law is not a sin per se, but it is a real pollution to the body, the temple of God.</p>

Leviticus 17:10-16

<p>10 'And whatever man of the house of Israel, or of the strangers who dwell among you, who eats any blood, I will set My face against that person who eats blood, and will cut him off from among his people.</p>	<p>This law applies to all people, the true believers, the false believers and the non believers who live with the true believers.</p> <p>In a house, there cannot be two standards.</p>
<p>11 For the life of the flesh is in the blood, and I have given it to you upon the altar to make atonement for your souls; for it is the blood that makes atonement for the soul.'</p> <p>12 Therefore I said to the children of Israel, 'No one among you shall eat blood, nor shall any stranger who dwells among you eat blood.'</p>	<p>The blood is the life of the flesh.</p> <p>Eating blood is an offense and also a pollution (abomination) against God.</p>
<p>13 Whatever man of the children of Israel, or of the strangers who dwell among you, who hunts and catches any animal or bird that may be eaten, he shall pour out its blood and cover it with dust;</p> <p>14 for it is the life of all flesh. Its blood sustains its life. Therefore I said to the children of Israel, 'You shall not eat the blood of any flesh, for the life of all flesh is its blood. Whoever eats it shall be cut off.'</p>	<p>Anyone who lives near or with the true believers is forbidden by God from consuming blood or flesh with blood in it.</p> <p>Flesh with blood in it is when the animals are not slaughtered appropriately, i.e., when their blood is not fully drained out. This does not apply to fish.</p> <p>(E.g., white or red Boudin sausages.) (E.g., all animals and birds sold in supermarkets are not slaughtered correctly.)</p>
<p>15 "And every person who eats what died naturally or what was torn by beasts, whether he is a native of your own country or a stranger, he shall both wash his clothes and bathe in water, and be unclean until evening. Then he shall be clean.</p> <p>16 But if he does not wash them or bathe his body, then he shall bear his guilt."</p>	<p>Dead carcass of clean animals cannot be eaten for they are unclean. This applies to everyone who lives with the true believers. Such a person who eats dead carcass is unclean until the evening and must bathe and also wash his clothes. (See Leviticus 11:39 above.)</p> <p>(E.g. road-kill, hunted and killed animals without draining their blood completely.)</p>

Acts 15:22-36

22 Then it pleased the apostles and elders, with the whole Ekklyssia (falsely translated as church), to send chosen men of their own company to Antioch with Paul and Barnabas, namely, Judas who was also named Barsabas, and Silas, leading men among the brethren.

23 They wrote this letter by them: The apostles, the elders, and the brethren, To the brethren who are of the Gentiles in Antioch, Syria, and Cilicia: Greetings.

This is an Apostolic Epistle (Letter) to all the Ekklyssias in Antioch and throughout all the world.

This is inspired by YHWH the Holy Spirit.

This was not a democratic meeting or a religious conference, but YHWH the Holy Spirit called them to unite and write this Epistle (Letter) to all the converted new Messianic believers (who are called now Christians).

24 Since we have heard that some who went out from us have troubled you with words, unsettling your souls, saying, "You must be circumcised and keep the law of Moses" to whom we gave no such commandment

The people described here as "some who went out from us" were not true believers. They are passionate and enthusiast people who claimed to accept Jesus, but they insisted in incorporating the rabbinic teachings of circumcision.

Notice, the language: "'You must be circumcised and keep the law of Moses" to whom we gave no such commandment." Moses never gave a law of circumcision. The circumcision was given to Abram (Abraham). Those people were of the Ebionite Sect pretending to be Messianic believers.

Today, there are some Messianic Jews who demand similar laws as did the Ebionites. Matthew 15:13 "Yeshua Jesus answered and said, "Every plant which My heavenly Father has not planted will be uprooted."

Also, the Ebionites gave Mohammed (in the sixth century) many of his doctrines and teachings. There is a great similarity between them.

I claim to be a Messianic Hebrew, not a Messianic Jew.

25 it seemed good to us, being assembled with one accord, to send chosen men to you with our beloved Barnabas and Paul,
26 men who have risked their lives for the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.
27 We have therefore sent Judas and Silas, who will also report the same things by word of mouth.

The assembly of the Apostles was not a religious conference, but they were led by YHWH the Holy Spirit who was their Head.

Today, religious conferences are either democratic, autocratic, or politically agenda driven meetings to stipulate new laws and rules.

<p>28 For it seemed good to the Holy Spirit, and to us, to lay upon you no greater burden than these necessary things: 29 that you abstain from things offered to idols, from blood, from things strangled, and from sexual immorality. If you keep yourselves from these, you will do well. Farewell.</p>	<p>Thus spoke YHWH the Holy Spirit:</p> <p>Abstain from unclean food. Abstain from participating in idols' lifestyle. Abstain from any meat with blood in it. Abstain from strangled animals. Abstain from any and all sexual relationship outside the marriage. (This means boy-girl friendships and all forms of hooking-up are abominations in the flesh against YHWH God.)</p>
<p>30 So when they were sent off, they came to Antioch; and when they had gathered the multitude together, they delivered the letter. 31 When they had read it, they rejoiced over its encouragement. 32 Now Judas and Silas, themselves being prophets also, exhorted and strengthened the brethren with many words. 33 And after they had stayed there for a time, they were sent back with greetings from the brethren to the apostles. 34 However, it seemed good to Silas to remain there. 35 Paul and Barnabas also remained in Antioch, teaching and preaching the word of the Lord, with many others also. 36 Then after some days Paul said to Barnabas, "Let us now go back and visit our brethren in every city where we have preached the word of the Lord, and see how they are doing."</p>	<p>The Apostles and men of God carried this Epistle (Letter) to Antioch and then to all the ekklyssias in the entire world, see Acts 15:36.)</p> <p>The Ekklyssias met always on the Sabbath (Saturday). They never met on Sunday. They did not worship the Sun-god and did not incorporate the Sun-god worship yet until three hundred years later.</p>

The rabbis changed the Laws of God. The Clean Food (Kashrut) Law are simple and they are demonstrated above.

If you seek the rabbinic Kashrut Laws you will find a complicated human mosaic of logic and illogic laws.

Remember the Words of the Messiah Yeshua Jesus against most of the Bible Teachers: the Pharisees (Rabbis), the Pastors, the Preachers, the Missionaries in Matthew 16 and 23:

Matthew 16:6-12 "Then Yeshua Jesus said to them, "Take heed and beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and the Sadducees." And they reasoned among themselves, saying, "It is because we have taken no bread." But Jesus, being aware of it, said to them, "O you of little faith, why do you reason among yourselves because you have brought no bread? Do you not yet understand, or remember the five loaves of the five thousand and how many baskets you took up? Nor the seven loaves of the four thousand and how many large baskets you took up? How is it you do not understand that I did not speak to you concerning bread?--but to beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and Sadducees." Then they understood that He did not tell them to beware of the leaven of bread, but of the doctrine of the Pharisees and Sadducees."

And,

Matthew 23:13 Yeshua Jesus said "Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you shut up the kingdom of heaven against men; for you neither go in yourselves, nor do you allow those who are entering to go in."

Final Conclusion:

(1) Clean Food Law apply to all Christians who are true believers.

(2) Breaking the Clean Food Law is not a sin per se, but it is pollution and abomination of the body which is the temple of God.
