

# **2022 DW Productions Rules & Show Information**

## **General Rules**

- 1) All WSCA Rules apply. Please see WSCA Rule Book for specific details.
  - a. It is available online.
- 2) You will need to pay for your stall, shavings, & electrical fees via credit card when you sign up. You will not be charged for any additional fees, until the end of the show.
  - a. If you want to pay for the additional fees with cash, Venmo or PayPal, you can do that in the show office.
- 3) Dress Code
  - a. WSCA Rules – See WSCA Rule Book
  - b. Does not apply to Friday night Gymkhanas or barrel races.
    - o Boots & Jeans are the requirements for dress code for fun shows/barrel race.
- 4) All dogs must be on a leash.
  - a. DW Productions Staff reserves the right to ask you to remove your dog from the arena & warm-up area for the safety of our exhibitors.
- 5) DW Productions reserves the right to change, add, combine, or move classes at any time.
- 6) You can come show for 1 day, 2 days, or all 3 days. You are still required to pay for a stall at Simon's & Mason city - even if you only come for 1 day.
- 7) No exhibition rides allowed.
- 8) A \$30.00 NSF fee plus bank fees will be charged on all returned checks
- 9) Any checks not cashed within 60 days will be considered void and will not be re-issued for any reason.
- 10) If you submit a payment using Paypal and do not send it using friends & family, you will be required to pay the transaction fee.
- 11) Must be present or have someone present for awards. No awards will be mailed unless payment arrangements are made for the shipping cost.
- 12) We reserve the right to measure ponies at any given time to make sure they meet height requirements.
  - a. If you have concerns related to pony height in a class, please find Dani in the office sooner than later and we will address any concerns.
- 13) You can only enter one like class.
  - a. Example 1: You cannot enter Solid or Colored horse halter & ranch horse conformation. You have to pick which one you want to enter.
  - b. Example 2: You cannot enter 2 & 3 year old Western Pleasure & your age division class for Western pleasure. You have to pick one or the other.
- 14) You cannot enter the walk/trot classes and the walk/trot/lope classes with the same horse.
  - a. The same horse can be used for both but must have a different rider.
  - b. The same rider can enter both but must use a different horse.
- 15) Walk-Trot Showmanship is the class you want to enter for those going in the Walk/Trot riding classes.
  - a. If you are going for Walk/Trot high point awards – you want to enter the walk/trot showmanship class rather than your age division showmanship class.
  - b. These showmanship classes count toward the Walk/Trot High Point Awards.
- 16) No membership required to come to any of my shows.
- 17) If you have any questions: Come check in at the office, even if you are pre-entered.
- 18) You need to attend 3 of 4 weekends to qualify for series awards.

## **Refund Policy:**

1. No refunds for pre-entries except in the situation of a Vet Out.
  - a. A full refund will be issued with a vet note up to 24 hrs prior to the event minus the office fee.
  - b. If you need to vet out the day of, a credit will be given for the full amount paid to be used at any other event within the same year.

2. No refunds for scratched classes.
3. You are required to pay for stalls, electrical, & shavings when you pre-enter. You will not be charged for your classes & office fee until after the show is complete.

## **Arrival & Start Times:**

- 1) A schedule for each show will be posted on my website and in each Facebook Event.
- 2) Arrival Times:
  - a. Mason City: Arrive any-time after 10 AM on the Friday prior to a show. Please do not arrive prior to 10AM.
    - i. Friday show starts at 4PM. Saturday & Sunday start at 8AM.
  - b. Dakota County Fairgrounds Farmington, MN Show:
    - i. Gamers: You can arrive any time after Noon on Friday.
      1. Show Start Times: Friday Show starts at 6PM, Saturday Starts at 9AM, Sunday Starts at 8AM
    - ii. Pleasure: You can arrive anytime after 3PM on Saturday
      1. If your stalls are not full on Friday night, I will notify you and give you the option to come in on Friday or earlier on Saturday.
  - c. Double H Arena: Arrival allowed anytime after Noon on Friday.
    - i. Friday Warm-Up Sessions & Exhibitions start at 1:30 on Friday.
    - ii. Show Starts at 9am Saturday & 8am Sunday.
  - d. Simon's Arena: You can arrive anytime after Noon on Friday. Shows start 8am Saturday & Sunday.
- 3) Office hours will vary show to show. This will be posted on each schedule.

## **General Stall & Electrical Hook-Up Information:**

### **Stalls:**

- 1) You are not required to pre-enter for each show. However, the stall fee will increase \$10/stall after the pre-entry date for my pleasure shows. Game shows stall fee will not change, however, I do have limited stalls available.
  - a. Stalls & Electric are assigned in order of payment received.
  - b. Simon's Arena – Cannon Falls, MN:
    - i. A stall is required to come show.
    - ii. Shavings must be purchased from Simon's. \$8 pre-entry, \$9 on-site.
    - iii. Single Stalls: \$65, Limited Double Stalls Available: \$130
    - iv. You do not have to clean out your stalls when you leave.
    - v. 3% Credit card fee assessed when you reserve them through Equiscribe.
  - c. North Iowa Events Center - Mason City:
    - i. A stall is required to come show. \$55 each.
    - ii. Shavings: You can bring your own, or purchase from the facility. \$10 per bag pre-entry, \$11 on-site.
    - iii. If you have a preference on the barn you want to be in, stalling requests are handled in order received and with payment only.
    - iv. You do not have to clean out your stalls when you leave.
    - v. 3% Credit card fee assessed when you reserve them through Equiscribe.
  - d. Dakota County – Farmington Show:
    - i. I only have 65 stalls available.
      1. Gamers have first rights to them for Friday night but will be asked to not stay Saturday night. Stalls must be cleaned out by 3pm.
      2. Pleasure horses can come in anytime after 3PM on Saturday
      3. They are reserved as first come, first served. Get your paperwork and payments to me.

**4. ALL STALLS MUST BE CLEANED OUT BEFORE YOU LEAVE!**

5. 3% credit card fee assessed when you reserve them. If you do not clean out your stalls you will be charged an additional \$30 per stall for us to clean them.
- e. Double H Arena-Mondovi, WI:
- i. 70 Stalls Available. \$50/weekend includes shavings. 3% credit card fee assessed when you reserve them.
    1. They are sold, first come – first serve.
  - ii. Additional Shavings available for purchase on-site.
  - iii. You do not have to clean out your stalls when you leave.

**Electricals:**

- a. Simon's: Limited Electricals Available.
  - i. Sold first come – first served.
  - ii. I will assign spots based on payment received.
  - iii. 3% credit card fee assessed.
- b. Mason City:
  - i. Unlimited electricals are available. Some spots have Water & Electric. \$35/night.
  - ii. You have the option to get an electrical for 1 night or 2 nights.
  - iii. Electricals are not assigned. Find a spot you like and come get a cord tag.
    1. You can save spots for friends, I don't care!
  - iv. 3% credit card fee assessed.
- c. Dakota County does not have electrical hook-ups.
  - i. However, if you plan to camp you must fill out the camping form. There is a fee for primitive overnight camping.
  - ii. Generators are allowed.
- d. Double H does not have electrical hook-ups.
  - i. Generators are allowed.
  - ii. No fee for overnight camping, only if you tie-out horses overnight and do not have a stall.

**Office Fees:**

- a. Simons – Flat Fee \$10 for the weekend.
- b. Game Shows:
  - i. Fright Night Barrel Race \$10/person – No Office Fee PeeWees.
  - ii. Saturday/Sunday: Flat Fee \$10 for the weekend.
- c. Pleasure Shows: \$5/day office fee.

**Tie-Outs or Overnight Pens:**

- d. Double H Arena:
  - i. Both are allowed. If you do not get a stall, you are required to pay a \$10/trailer tie out fee.
- e. Dakota County: You can tie-out but you are not allowed to set up pens.
- f. Not allowed at Simon's or in Mason City.

- If you used Equiscribe for MN Pinto or Champ Show in 2021, use your same log-in email and password.

- If you have never used it, go to the link and set-up your account.
- Step-By-Step Instructions are available on my website or email me with any questions.
- If you get an error of any kind, please email me with details of what you were trying to do and the error you got. Equiscribe support will help us with any issues we come across.

**Pre-Entry Dates for Pleasure shows:** You DO NOT have to pre-enter. Stall fee goes up \$10/stall after Pre-Entry date.

- April 23-24: Pre-Entry Deadline is Wed. April 13<sup>th</sup>
- May 20-22: Pre-Entry Deadline is Wed. May 11<sup>th</sup>
- July 1-3: Pre-Entry Deadline is Wed. June 22<sup>nd</sup>
- August 14<sup>th</sup> – No pre-entry deadline but stalls are very limited, so you will want to reserve ASAP.
- October 7-9: Pre-Entry Deadline September 28<sup>th</sup>

### Pleasure Patterns:

- 1) Patterns will be uploaded for each pattern class in the entry system.
- 2) They will be uploaded the week before the show, once they are all available from my judges.

### Gamers:

#### 1) FRIDAY NIGHT POLES & PEEWEE/OPEN 4D/YOUTH 3D

- Pre-Entry appreciated but you can also sign-up on site.
- Barrel Race Entries are not done using Equiscribe. I will have an entry form on-site for you or you can pre-enter online.

- If you plan to show Sat or Sunday, make sure your account is set-up in Equiscribe before you get to the barn.

#### 2) Sat & SUN Barrel Sidepot

- \$100 Added each day – bring cash & sign up in the office. \$10 EF each day.

#### 3) Internet service

- Is terrible in Mondovi. Make sure your accounts are activated before you get to the barn & you sign up for as much as possible before you arrive.
- I can help you add classes but I cannot set-up your accounts.

#### 4) Stalls are paid for with your CC when you reserve them online & they come with shavings.

#### 5) Classes & office fees are not paid for until the weekend of the show.

- If you do not want the 3% cc fee added to your class & office fee, you can pay with cash, venmo or paypal at the show.
- Office Fee: \$10 Friday Night/person – No office fee for PeeWee.
- \$10 Flat Fee for Saturday/Sunday

### Awards:

#### 1) Calculating Points:

- a. Points are calculated using the WSCA point system
  - i. 6,5,4,3,2,1
  - ii. If a class is not full, points are awarded based off of the number of exhibitors in the class.
    1. Example: If there are 4 exhibitors in the class, Points Given are 4, 3, 2, 1.
  - iii. In the event of a tie: The person that received the most 1<sup>st</sup> places will be the winner.
    - i. If there is a tie based off of the number of 1<sup>st</sup> place wins, then we review 2<sup>nd</sup> place wins, then 3<sup>rd</sup>

place wins, and so on until the tie is broken.

## 2) Weekend High-Point Awards:

- a. Belt Buckles for Grand Champion in each Division.
- b. Reserve Champion High Point Awards for each division
- c. Neck Ribbons for each Jackpot Class Winner
- d. 1 Non-Stock Type Grand Champion Award
- e. Ribbons for 1<sup>st</sup> Place – 6<sup>th</sup> Place.
  - a. Ribbons are outside the office – You come and get them as you earn them.

## 3) 2022 Award Divisions:

- A. Pleasure
  - Ranch Horse, Walk-Trot Ranch Horse, Walk-Trot, Pony, PeeWee 10 & Under, Junior 11-13, Intermediate 14-17, Senior 18-34, Sr+ 35-49, Sr. 50+
  - Non-Stock Type All Ages (Award not belt buckle)
- B. Games
  - Pony, Pee Wee, Junior, Intermediate, Sr. 18-34, Sr.+ 35 & Over
- C. There is a list of which classes count toward each division posted on my website.

## 4) 2022 Series Awards:

- a. **Pleasure:** Awards given out at North Iowa Events Center following the last class of the day October 9<sup>th</sup>.
  - a. Miguel Aguilar Custom Work Saddle Gift Certificate or \$2700 can be used toward your dream show saddle!
    - i. Awarded to the horse/rider combo with the most accumulated points from the series shows.
  - b. **New For 2022:** High Point Series Year-End Buckles for each of the 10 divisions!
  - c. **Non-Stock Type:** Overall Series Grand & Reserve Champion Buckles
    1. Sponsored by: Liz Johnson
  - d. **Halter: NEW for 2022!** Overall Series Solid & Colored Horse Halter Grand Champion Buckles
    1. Sponsored by: Jodie Distad Performance Horses/Broadway Farm
  - e. **Driving:** Grand & Reserve Champion Buckles Sponsored by an Anonymous Sponsor!
- b. **Games:** Awards given out at Dakota County in Farmington following the last class of the Day August 13<sup>th</sup>.
  - i. High Point Timed Event saddle awarded to the horse/rider combo with the most accumulated points from the series shows.
  - b. **New For 2022:** High Point Series Year-End Buckles for each Division!
  - c. Points from all Saturday & Sunday classes count for Series Year End High Point Awards, except Ribbon Race.
  - d. Not all classes count towards series year end awards. See class list at the end of this document.
  - e. Points are live in the entry system. Make sure you audit them!

## Ranch Horse Classes

### **General Rules for Ranch Horse Classes:**

- 1) Ranch Horses cannot compete in a ranch horse class & another division class.
  - a. Example: Solid or Colored Halter & Ranch Horse Conformation. Your age division western pleasure & Ranch Horse Western Pleasure. You have to pick which one you want to show in, you cannot do both.
  - b. However, if you show on a day without any ranch classes you can show in any classes you would like. Each day is a new show.
- 2) Same horse/rider combination cannot compete in walk/trot classes and w/t/l classes in the same day. Each day is a new show.
  - a. The same rider can show in each division with a different horse.
  - b. The same horse can go in both divisions with a different rider.
- 3) General Rules:

  - A. No hoof polish.
  - B. No braided or banded manes or tail extensions.
  - C. Clipping is up to the discretion of the exhibitor.
  - D. Horses 5 years of age & under may be shown two handed in a snaffle or bosal. Horses over 6 years of age must be shown in a bit one handed.
  - E. Follow WSCA rule for bits.
  - F. Equipment with silver should not count over a good working outfit. Silver on bridles and saddles is discouraged.
  - G. Attire: Appropriate western attire includes a long sleeve shirt with collar and cuff that has buttons, or snaps that must be fastened at the wrist, a western hat and boots with heels. Adding chinks, wild rags or western scarves are optional.
  - H. Safety helmets (hard hats) are allowed in all classes.

## **Barrel Sidepot: \$100 Added Per Day**

### 1) Barrel Sidepot Information:

- a. This is your opportunity to win some money! 100% of side pot entry fee + added money are paid out!
- b. If you enter the side pot, placings will be based off of your run in your barrel class.
  - a. This is not an additional run.
- c. # of spots paid out will be determined by the # of entries in the side pot
  - We usually pay 1-3 spots in each D. That is 8-12 people that will win money each day!
- d. Each horse may only be entered once per day.
- e. You cannot circle the barrel more than 1 time during your barrel class.
- f. 4D – Full Second split between each D (1,1,1)
- g. Cost to enter: \$10/horse per day
- h. Must be entered each day before the first barrel class of the day starts.
- i. We drag every 10 horses or as needed for the arena conditions. This will stay consistent for all horses that run that day.

## **Jackpot Hunt Seat Pleasure & Jackpot Western Pleasure:**

- 1) All Jackpot classes are NOT WSCA Qualifying but they do count for Weekend High Point and Series Year End Points.
- 2) \$10 Entry Fee/day
- 3) 50% pay back + 100% of Sponsor added Money – Jackpot Added Money will vary each weekend.
  - a. Minimum 2 Spots will be paid out. 60/40. TBD each weekend based on # of entries & sponsor added money.
    - i. 1<sup>st</sup> & 2 place will always be paid →Possibly 3<sup>rd</sup> place if that makes sense with the number of entries.
    - ii. If 3 spots are paid it will be 50/30/20

## **Tiny Tot Classes**

### Tiny Tot Rules:

- 1. They are expected to have a mentor in the arena with them. They can walk right with them or just be in the arena, either is fine and the judge will score accordingly.
- 2. They can share a horse that is being shown in a like class.

3. They have to be 7 & under as of Jan. 1st.
4. They cannot show in any other classes, except tiny tot & lead line.
5. Series points are accumulated points based on horse/exhibitor combo for each class.
6. Please do whatever is needed to keep them safe. I want this to be fun, rewarding, and safe for them to show in the arena!

**Tiny Tot Awards: Sponsored by Boisen/Wright Families**

- a. Overall Series Grand & Reserve Champion Buckles for each division. Will be given out at the last show of the 2022 Series!
  - i. Tiny Tot Halter
  - ii. Tiny Tot Showmanship
  - iii. Lead Line
- b. A trophy for each class winner each day!
- c. A ribbon for every exhibitor!
- d. Goodie bag for each lead line exhibitor each day as usual 😊
