About Minister Doniel Ervin, D.Min./BSBM



Ordained Minister and Missionary according to the Gospel of Jesus Christ in Healing and Deliverance, entrepreneur and consultant in the field of business administration, management, and tax services, Doniel Ervin was born in New Orleans, LA, in 1965 and baptized at the age of 12, rededicating her life to the Lord in 1988. Months later being filled with the Holy Ghost at a home prayer meeting, she had a life changing experience in 1989 leading to Doniel yielded her gifts and talents to the Lord. Her life of service includes 25 years of dedication to the body of Christ as a children and youth pastor, evangelist, intercessor, arts & drama, and prophetic dance

ministry member, young adult and adult Sunday school teacher and church administrator.

In September, 1992, she was called into the ministry as a Youth Pastor under the leadership of

Pastor Joe and Alice Martin, at Divine Grace Temple in New Orleans, LA until 1995. In February, 1998, she was anointed and licensed as an evangelist under the leadership of Pastors Thomas and Barbara Cole, at True Love Full Gospel Church in Westwego, LA until 2005, where she ministered at the United Mission for the homeless, sick, elderly and other outreaches throughout New Orleans, LA. In January, 2007, she was ordained as Minister of the Gospel under the leadership of Apostle Derrick and Pastor Stephanie Hicks at Love in Action Church and in October that same year, God graced her to study, train and be ordained as a Minister of Healing and Deliverance, under the leadership of the late Charles and Frances Hunter, at City of Lights School of Healing



and Deliverance Ministry in Kingwood, TX. Doniel's testimony opened many opportunities at speaking engagements to share her healing and deliverance testimony at prayer conferences, community outreaches, and various church services.

She had the privilege of ministering the gospel of Jesus Christ in Lagos, Nigeria in August 2006,



and Montego Bay, Jamaica in July 2007, followed by a prophetic prayer assignment with the House of David and Elijah List Ministries in Israel in 2008. In January 2009, she was invited to join the Wailing Women Worldwide Intercessors to Kampala, Uganda and Nairobi, Kenya, where God's call to the mission field became a divine passion to give support of eight wonderful children in Uganda: Mwere Village under the leadership of Pastor Muhinda Sande.

By God's grace Pastor Sande and his team fell in love with her spirit and the love for the children and had

appointed and assigned her as the International Secretary Liaison for the Children with a Mission

(USA) renamed as ONE WAY LOVE MINISTRIES (2015). "Where my Father God calls me I will go! Is her heartfelt desire?" As a missionary in Kampala, Uganda, serving financially to the underprivileged children, youth and widows joined with Pastor Sande the ministry has grown. Her mission is to fulfill that which is said in Isaiah 58; that each child will live in a clean, safe and stable environment by providing food, clothing, clean water, medical supplies and soon a future campus. As of today, Pastor Sande with support from Min. Doniel has fed over two thousand children and youth and has established a temporary church and water well. The vision now is to BUILD!



In 2010, she was commissioned by Redeem By the Blood Ministries (RBTBM) as Pastor/Overseer from Restoration Gateway Ministries by Pastor K. Tolman of Portland, Oregon. This organization serves both the youth and elderly who have been emotionally, spiritually and physically oppressed and serves the homeless in Southwest Houston community. Through the "Redeem Team Mobile Feeding Unit", she served over 25 homeless families

who live nearby on the corner highways. Since then, every Thanksgiving and

Christmas she assists in serving over 150 families as well as assists individuals with community resources to obtain state ID and helped with job searches.

The organization has provided shoes, personal items, cloths, coats, blankets, pillows and some toys for the children. Min. Doniel had wonderful support through the HEB and Fiesta grocery stores that

sponsored the food and drinks to make this mission successful each year. With the progression of the ministry in 2014, she was commissioned for international efforts as a "Ministry of Zion"



from Glory of Zion International by Chuck Pierce in Corinth, TX and overseer and co-founder "Redeemed By The Blood Ministries International", a 501(c)(3) non-profit organizations.

With continuous personal development and spiritually growth; financial challenges arose but Jesus always causes Doniel to triumph. She strongly believes that the body of Christ must possess the land within the marketplace for the Kingdom of God, (Duet 8:18). Doniel started her business venture due to countless job search rejections as a result of recovery from colorectal cancer which caused her to be unemployed, and

the unexpected transition due to Hurricane Katrina in 2005. After countless hours spent researching trying how to start a business, she started "Organize N' Disguise" in 2007, a profitable consulting service business as well as became the president of "Ervin Management Group (EMG2011)", a premier training specialist that offers in-person and online eservices to educate start-up businesses, entrepreneurs, and non-profit companies in organizational development and income tax services.





God provided more resources through the American Recovery Act of 2009 in which Doniel received a grant of \$6,000 to start a licensed family-home childcare by December 2009. She opened Yeshua's Kingdom Academy in June 2010 and has since served over 330 children and families with childcare services, and afterschool care. In 2014 God opened doors to implement a summer camp program called, "Momma's Dee Boot Camp", where she teaches through the Bible in drama, art and dance lessons, as well as drills to teach the 66 books of the Bible. As an educator and

director of childcare, she acquired her Child Development Associate (CDA-3/2012); became a member and endorser of the State of Texas Association of Infant Mental Health (TAIMH) and a certified Infant Mental Health Specialist Level I (IMH-E (I) 6/2012).

Doniel's expertise ranges from administration, marketing to management, non-profit services to volunteer recruiting, and training staff. Her proficiency throughout her years within the workforce of New Orleans, LA and Houston, TX earned her many *Customer Service Awards*. In July 2015, she received the *Certificate of Excellence Award* "Return Count and Net Payments"

from Ivy Investment as Office Manager/Tax Consultant. Under Doniel's leadership, Ivy Investment substantially improved profitability at her location over 35% in sales growth during her third tax season.

As an entrepreneur she is enthusiastic, accessible, and full of great ideas. She collaborates with her clients to achieve her business motto, "Let all things be done, decently and in order" (1 Corinthians 14:40). She also offers a wide range of services and works with an extensive network of capable partners to deliver cost-effective business solutions including strategy, audit defense, refund reviews, manuals, planning and general management.



As a business consultant, Doniel works with myriad industries such as automotive, charity, daycare, e-commerce, home-health care, environmental, landscaping, printing and publishing, radio broadcasting, professional services, and construction. With great extent the success of two businesses and a non-profit organization, she received the 2015 SMALL BUSINESS AWARD OF THE YEAR from the 2nd Annual Christian Business Expo. 

Presently, she's published her first book, "Innocence Invasion, When fear shows up, Faith Triumphs" with her publisher, Marionette Publishing in May 2016. Doniel shares her love for God, crippling the fear she faced of the unknown, and lead her to triumphant faith. This project has opened doors already for workshops and seminars in 2017 with several other opportunities to follow.
