



CIAAG 8-Point Strategy: Prevention

CIAAG has developed an 8-Point Strategy to address healthcare disparities in the nation. Recent policy changes devised to combat drug misuse have exacerbated healthcare disparities in a number of areas.

We have identified 8 areas of public policy that need to be addressed in order to accomplish the nation's goals of reducing healthcare costs, decreasing disability rates and overdose rates.

The 4th point of the 8-Point Strategy is focused on Oversight, including but not limited to, the following:

- Public health campaign focused on the importance of preventative health measures. Focusing on the repercussions of failure to do so. Highlighting the damaging impacts of chronic pain and illness on an individuals life and how preventative care can help ensure a healthier outcome.
- Public health campaign on the dangers of illicit fentanyl. Failure to educate the fact that street drugs are not diverted prescriptions and are, in fact, illicit substances put into a pill press
