As you know, over the last few months the Friends of Ashby Bath Grounds have been developing a project for the Bath Grounds which will include a new all-weather footpath. We recently held very encouraging discussions with the Heritage Lottery Fund to raise the balance of monies we need to make this project a reality and we are now developing that application.

To be successful it will need to emphasise the fascinating history of the Bath Grounds and include a significant level of community involvement and heritage learning activities to complement the capital works. We are currently working with the Museum and History Society on developing the educational programme. Subjects we are working towards for our heritage project plan for spring/summer 2016 include;

archaeological research, a 'Bath Grounds Trail', a mosaic to be installed in the Bath Grounds, depicting the Ivanhoe Spa, talks/walks and presentations of the history of the Ivanhoe Spa and its association with the Bath Grounds, a dramatic production with school and community participation, our very own song/music composition 'the Ballard of the Bath Grounds'.
