

Introducing Our Adjudicators

Sarah Konecsni - Piano

Sarah is active as a pianist, clinician, adjudicator, composer, accompanist, teacher, and examiner for the Royal Conservatory of Music. She is in demand as a piano and theory teacher, and her students have received over 50 silver/gold medals for the highest marks in piano examinations in every grade from Preparatory A through Grade 10 RCM. Sarah's students have also won many scholarships in provincial competitions, and also at the Saskatchewan provincial finals, where several students were judged the most outstanding performer of the competition.



Sarah holds an ARCT from the Royal Conservatory of Music in Toronto and a Licentiate diploma from Trinity College in London, England. A recipient of nearly all awards for piano performance provincially, including soloist with the Regina Symphony Orchestra, she was the Young Artist for Western Canada and performed ten concerts from BC, Saskatchewan and Manitoba; she was also a winner of the Sister Geraldine Boyle award for the most outstanding competitor of the Provincial Finals in 1994.

In 2003, she was awarded a grant from the Saskatchewan Arts Board to present a series of seven concerts throughout Saskatchewan to present her compositions to the public. Sarah was also the winner of the 'Call for Compositions' national competition for a piano piece for Canada Music Week 2009. Her compositions reflect both her Saskatchewan surroundings, as well as many world cultures, as experienced on her many travels. She derives her inspiration from her students, and strives to both excite and delight pianists with her descriptive and imaginative compositions.

Sarah has a large class of talented students from beginners to Licentiate level. She resides on an acreage south of Regina, with her husband, Lee, her son, Armand, and their two beautiful dogs.

Chris MacRae - Vocal

Having been praised for his musicality and dramatic portrayals, and possessing “a beautiful and sonorous tenor voice,” Christopher MacRae has appeared across North America in a wide range of stage and concert repertoire. In 2015 he received a Doctor of Musical Arts in Vocal Performance from Boston University, and holds additional degrees in music from McGill University and the University of Calgary.



In 2000 he made his professional debut with Calgary Opera, performing the role of Dr. Blind in *Die Fledermaus*, and has since appeared across Canada and the US with companies like Opera on the Avalon, Toronto Summer Music Festival, The Banff Centre, and the Boston University Opera Institute. As a proponent of contemporary works, selected highlights of his stage credits include Sir Philip in *Owen Wingrave*, the Male Chorus in *The Rape of Lucretia*, McAlpine in *Filumena (Estacio)*, The Governor & Vanderdenur in *Candide*, Pirelli in *Sweeney Todd*, The Tenor in *Six Characters in Search of an Author (Weisgall)*, Sheldon in *Later the Same Evening (Musto)*, and created the roles of Seth as a Man in John Beckwith’s historical opera *Taptoo!*, and The Doctor in Lorena Orozco’s English adaptation of *The Waiting Room*.

He has been frequently engaged as a concert soloist in works such as Orff’s *Carmina Burana*, Beethoven’s *Symphony No. 9* and *Choral Fantasy*, Mozart’s *Requiem* and *Mass in C Minor*, Verdi’s *Requiem*, Handel’s *Messiah* and *Theodora*, MacMillian’s *Celtic Mass of the Sea*, Britten’s *St. Nicola Cantata*, Elgar’s *The Kingdom*, Bach’s *Magnificat* and *Christmas Oratorio*, and Rachmaninoff’s *Vespers*.

Dr. MacRae is a member of the National Association of Teachers of Singing (NATS) and currently serves the President of the Arkansas Chapter. He has presented at the Federation for the Humanities and Social Sciences Congress in Calgary, the International Symposium on Singing and Song in St. John’s Newfoundland, and the NATS Southern Region Conference and Student Auditions.

Most recently Dr. MacRae was on faculty at the University of Arkansas, where he received the ‘Outstanding Mentor Award’ three times. He has worked with a wide variety of students who have gone on to win numerous auditions and competitions, and are pursuing a variety of careers in music. As of Fall 2021, Dr. MacRae has joined the faculty at the University of Regina.

Gilles Turcotte - Band

Gilles Turcotte was born in Saskatoon where he studied with Margaret Wilson and obtained undergraduate degrees in both clarinet performance and in French education from the University of Saskatchewan in 1985 and 1993 respectively. He recently retired from a 21 year career with the Saskatchewan Health Authority to devote more time and energy to return to performing music and instructing clarinetists of all ages. It feels good to re-establish connections with the broader music community while returning to the career he maintained for 30 years.



Gilles has performed in recital as well as in large and chamber ensembles from Ontario to British Columbia and North of the Arctic Circle. Career highlights include performing with the Saskatoon Symphony Orchestra for 10 seasons; participating in the Music Performance and Communication program in Toronto, organizing and participating in 4 Northern tours under the guidance of George Zukerman and producing and recording a solo CD entitled “Demografx” for which he was nominated for a Western Canadian Music Award. Gilles has also been recorded by the CBC.

Gilles has had considerable experience as an educator. He directed grade school bands and served as an adjudicator for the SMFA for a number of years. Gilles has extensive experience as a clinician and private instructor offering his services for lessons, sectionals and master classes for the SBA Honour Band, SBA Summer Band Camps and several schools throughout the province. Gilles pays particular attention in finding the key issues that prevent young musicians from fully realizing their potential on their instrument. He is the first to celebrate when his students begin to understand and control these key concepts.

Gilles is currently performing with the Saskatoon Symphony Orchestra and other chamber groups as opportunities arise. He also contributes to the community by rehearsing and performing with groups such as Reedy, Set, Go – Saskatoon’s Clarinet Choir, North Saskatchewan Wind Orchestra and the newly formed Saskatchewanwinds. He lives on an acreage with his wife, Juliane, 2 horses, 4 cats and their dog, Sadie. Our son, Félix, has been living and studying in Berlin, Germany for over 10 years. When not involved in music or farming related activity Gilles loves scuba diving extensively throughout the province and Mexico.




SMFA President's Message


