


## Update on Andrew ...

# Yes, you read this right ...

Last week, I read that 25 major cities across our nation have outlawed feeding the homeless in the streets. Even ministries were denied permits to feed the poor. Clearly, this is not right. People perish for a lack of food, and knowledge. I often wonder "How did this happen?"

Going in quietly, w/o 'sounding our horn,' only Jesus and those in need know we were there! So, rather than walk past those who are homeless, I will stop and ask, "So, what's your story?" I find 3 stories over and again.

- Some, mostly men, are homeless due to

  poor decisions: drugs, alcohol,
  wrecklessness, rebellion, and
  lawlessness = hiding from the law!
- 2. Some are homeless due to mental illness and past abuse resulting in a huge lack of trust and great fear.
- Others are skilled labourers, who've never been out of work in their lives.

  Some of these men are working, but not making enough to pay rent.

Therefore, it is God's heart that comes first in our lives as His children. We must follow Jesus where He leads, and do whatever He is doing in the moment. We can do this easily, in secret, not letting our right hand know what our left hand is doing ... selah. We are hidden in Christ. ♥

So, do not let anything or anyone rob you of your joy, your peace, or your acts of kindness!!! ♥ Forgive, release and keep moving forward, eyes on Jesus ... take His hand and let Him lead you. It might get bumpy, but not to worry, He's got you! ♥ Hey!

### Drive-By Blessings ...

He said, "You have given me so much more than money! Thank you." I quickly assured him of God's faithfulness to provide. He asked for contact info, so I wrote on his cardboard sign ...

Manteca gas station ... old man, clearly a meth addict, going through the trash, cheerfully received; In Tracy, 2 men and a woman standing on the corner outside Costco ... and the list goes on, each one receiving His Word which does not return void, but prospers wherein it is sent!

Jesus knows every hair on each of their heads! What we do for the least of these, we have done it unto Him! Even as we are walking or driving by, we can still bless and impart the blessing of God Most High! Jesus saves! Hey!

This last visit included some light-hearted fun as the residents were treated to "The Shamrocks," a senior line dancing group. Standing in the back of the room, suddenly Jesus set my feet to dancing! Janetta ... She was first on my list, for she was very close to crossing over ... When I got to her room, I gave her daughter a reassuring hug, and positioned myself at the head of the bed. Taking Janetta's hand, I kissed her forehead. Her daughter had to take a call, trusting her mother to me. Waiting before the Lord, to my surprise, the Holy Spirit began to sing the song of the Lord over her ... a peaceful and comforting flow of His loving embrace. Jesus took her home that evening.
