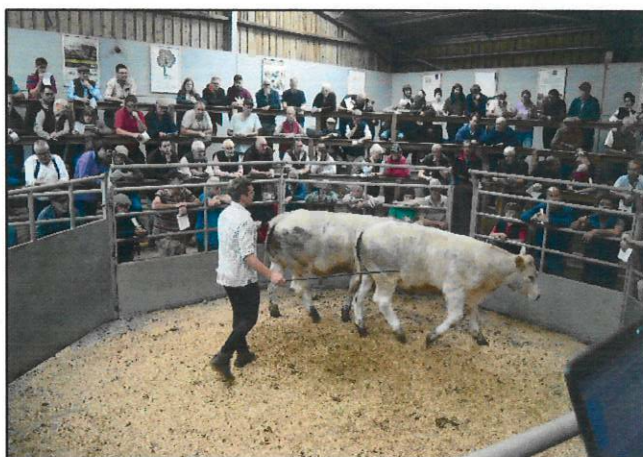

Prime New Season Lambs to £144.00 – Grazing Ewes to £129.50

EXMOOR FARMERS REPORT A FANTASTIC TRADE AT CUTCOMBE!

An improved entry of 758 sheep forward for sale to a blistering trade, much better than anticipated as other Centres seem to be reporting a slight reduction in Trade.

Prime New Season Lambs (334), top price of the day from KJ Parker for a pair of Texel x lambs at £144.00 (55kgs). This was followed by GG Gribble who saw their pen of 52.5kg lambs to £140.50 and J Brown saw a pen of six 52kgs to £140.00 being the top price/kg at **269ppk**. TJ Buckingham saw his pen of the same weight to £136.50 and 50kgs lambs in a run for RF Jones topped at £133.80, others from the same home for a pen of 48kgs to £128.20 and seven more the same weight to £126.20. Other noted prices from ER Dascombe & Son, who topped at £133.00 with J Brown's second pen of 50kgs at £128.20, Mrs C Smyth saw her pen of 56kgs lambs to £129.50, followed up with her second pen at £125.80. A run from L Williams sold to a top of £127.20 (49kgs).

The overall average for the 45kg + lambs was **262.26p/kg**.

Medium weight lambs 45kgs to £116.80 for TJ Buckingham, 44kgs from GG Gribble to £115.80, RB & JE Stephens saw their pen of 45kg lambs to £113.80 and a pen of ten from Polly Curling the same weight to £113.20. A second pen from L Williams hit £112.00 (44kgs) and the same weight lambs from G Matravvers hit £107.20, RF Jones saw his pen to £107.00 and G Matravvers second pen at £106.80. A first pen from C Govier of 42.5kg lambs hit £105.20 and 42kg lambs from D & M Elliott to £105.00 also.

Lighter weights, 39kgs from S & J Baker hit £94.20.

With fresh Buyers adding to the mix this week, a noticeable jump in the demand for lambs and we now require many more in the forthcoming weeks.

Grazing Ewes & Cull Rams (224), trade was on fire! Top price at £129.50 for Mrs C Smyth. A new Vendor, TJ Didcock saw his pen to £128.00, Howetown Farm Ltd saw his to £126.50, ER Dascombe & Son equalled this with Luckyard Farm Ltd selling a run to £124.00. C Harding's top price £123.50, D & M Elliott £119.00, L Williams £118.00, Howetown Farm Ltd second pen to £117.00, C Harding second pen to £113.50; the list goes on!

An absolute corker of a trade with the averages for the top six Vendors: L Williams ewes ave £118.00, C Smyth ave £113.00, TJ Didcock ave £115.00, Luckyard Farm Ltd ave £108.27, D & M Elliott ave £103.67, Howetown Farm Ltd ave £100.00.

When the trade is this good it begs the question why we weren't full to the rafters with ewes with the opportunity to wean now available and the demand as seen and prices to really back it up, we hope to see a full market in a fortnights time.

We hope that Vendors will please notify us in advance of your anticipated entries for the next sale on Wednesday 11th August. We continue in our fortnightly pattern now for prime lambs and cull ewes at Cutcombe. Blackmoor Gate Market Report – Monday 9th August 2021

A Flying Trade! Store Lambs to £97.50 – Grazing Ewes to £79.00

A much larger entry of 1096 sheep through Blackmoor Gate on Monday this week which saw 1056 store lambs sold to a flying trade, much better than anticipated, with an average standing at £86.12 up £3.00 on a fortnight ago and the top price for a pen of 36 lambs from KW & S Branfield at £97.50.

Following noted prices included CS Jeanes with a pen at £97.00, A Sanders at £96.80, a double pen of 40 lambs from D & M Ridd & Son hit £96.00, S Smyth saw his pen of 25 away at £94.50, with Part Croscombe Partnership selling to £94.00 which was equalled by a pen from G South.

Howetown Farms saw their pen of 50 lambs to £93.50, DJ Facey saw his pen away at £93.00 and DG Pile saw a pen of 21 away at £92.20.

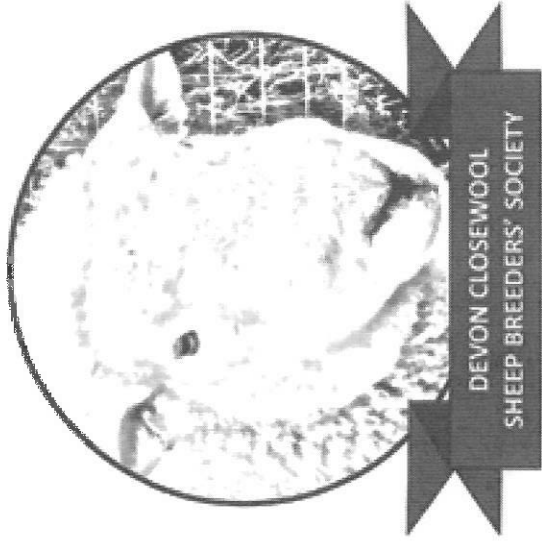
With the average standing at £86.00, some of the smaller lambs falling below that, still making over £80.00 a head look extremely well sold, we could have sold twice the number of lambs today to best advantage.

40 Grazing ewes forward sold to an average of £51.00 and topped at £79.00 for CS Jeans, with others to £71.00 for SJ Trawin and Lee Abbey Fellowship saw their top pen at £67.00.

Exmoor Horns from Middle Dean Farm topped at £62.00 with others to £59.00.

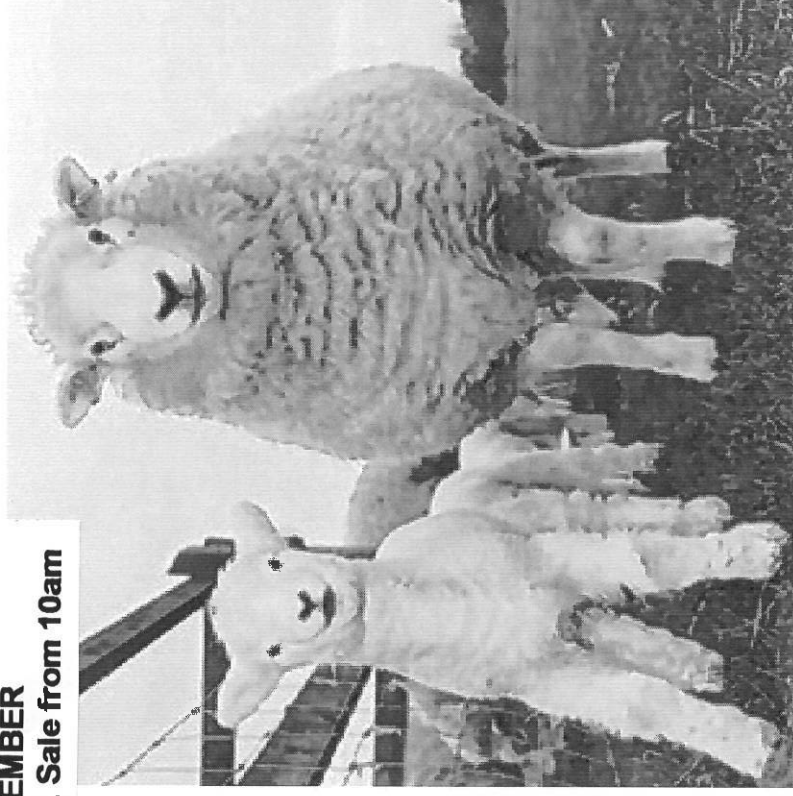

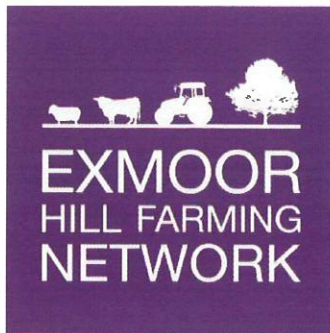

Are you looking to complete your NPTC Level 2 Certificate of Competence in the Transport of Animals by Road (short journeys). You have up to an hour to complete the assessment in the form of a multiple choice paper of 27 questions (21 correct answers required to pass).

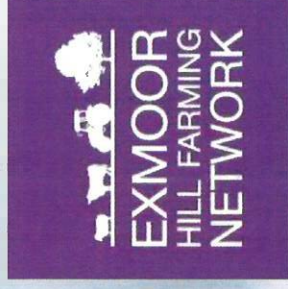
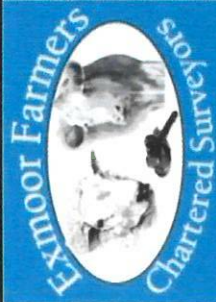
