MAXIMISE YOUR MAIZE YIELDS

Cob Ripeness



Large well filled determinate cobs with large number of grain sites for maximum starch production.

Cob held low on the plant. Early starch lay down.

Cob ripening days after Picker + 18

Maturity Group



Good maturity for favourable maize sites. Early grain maturity with extended harvesting window from green plants. Very even growth throughout the season from spring vigour to harvest maturity.

Quality & Digestibility



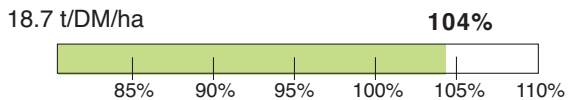
Good levels of ME and starch from mature grains on a longer season variety. Excellent Cell Wall Digestibility 60.1% which allows more maize to be fed.

Plant Description



Tall plant with low regular cob position. Medium green in colour with good vigour in the spring. Green plant at harvest allowing the full growing season to be utilised.

Yield



Sow at 42,500 to 45,000 seeds per acre (105,000 to 111,000 seeds/ha) to maximise output. Potential for huge Dry Matter yield at 30%DM. Excellent performance in MGA Under Film Trials with highest yield and ME.
