Red Mass: Bishop Kihneman will celebrate a Red Mass on Sunday, October 16, 2022, 11:00 am at Nativity B.V.M. Cathedral, 870 Howard Avenue, Biloxi. The White Mass, named after the white coats worn by medical professionals, was established in the 1930's. The White Mass is intended to bless the entire medical profession for the coming year. Doctors and nurse practitioners are invited to wear their white coats and be a part of the procession at the beginning of Mass.
