Eligibility

All competitors must be members in good standing in one of the Table Tennis Associations of the Atlantic Provinces.

All competitors must be Canadian citizens or permanent residents, with at least six (6) months residence in Atlantic Canada for the period immediately preceding the first day of the Championships.

In Team events, players must have resided in that province for a period of at least six (6) months preceding the first day of the Championships.

For age-restricted events, players must meet the age requirement as of Jan 1st, 2023.

For rating-restricted events, players will be eligible using the latest available TTCAN rating period at the time of the draw.

For doubles events, the combined rating of the pair will be used.

If a player does not have a TTCAN rating, then the Tournament Committee may assign an estimated rating for that player and remove him/her from any event(s) for which he/she would then be ineligible.

Equipment

Balls: BUTTERFLY A40 Plastic White



Players are responsible to ensure their rackets and clothing meet the requirements set by the ITTF Laws and Regulations. The Tournament Referee makes the final decision on the legality of rackets and clothing. Note: No white shirts or shorts.

Default Time

The default time will be 5 min. past the initial time of the announcement of a match.

Discipline

Players showing mannerisms or behaviors which may unfairly affect an opponent, offend spectators, or bring the sport of Table Tennis into disrepute are subject to warnings, penalties or disqualifications as outlined under ITTF Regulation 3.5.2.

Draws - May 12th

The draws will be conducted according to accepted standards and will be witnessed by an impartial observer. Ratings used will be the current available at the time of the draws on the TTCAN website. Players will be separated by Prov. Association and School or Club at the discretion of the Tournament Referee. A copy of the completed draws will be sent to the Team Managers, as per the Team Entry Form, at least one week prior to the start of the competition.

Team play will be a race to three. Each competing team must have no fewer than three (3) players and not more than four (4) players.

If a province does not send a team in a particular category, then the host province reserves the right to enter a "B" team in that category.

All team members must enter their respective Championship singles and U-19 singles events.

Matches will be best 3 out of 5.

Format will be Olympic style: (A,B,C and X,Y,Z)

AvsX BvsY Dbls(TBD) (AorB)vsZ Cvs(XorY)

Individual Events

Players may enter a maximum of (5) five events, with not more than three (3) singles or three (3) doubles. (i.e. 3 singles & 2 doubles or 2 singles & 3 doubles)

All singles events will have a Round-Robin of (3) three (if possible) in the preliminary rounds, and be of single elimination style thereafter.

All matches will be best 3 out of 5, except the finals of the Men's and Women's Championship Singles which will be best of 4 out of 7.All players must umpire upon request by the Control Desk.

The Tournament Referee reserves the right to combine or cancel events based on number of entries. Applicable fees will be refunded.

Seeding

For the Championship Singles, U-19 Singles and U-15 Singles only, defending Champions will be seeded first.

Entry Costs

Team Events - \$30.00 per team. The team roster and fee are to be submitted by the Provincial Association and received no later than Friday, April 28th.
