Q. Why is the body of our Lord represented by the bread and the blood with wine?

A. As bread as the power of nourishing our bodies, and of sustaining the present life so the same power is in the body of our Lord for the spiritual nourishment of our souls. And as with wine the hearts of men are cheered, their powers renewed, and the whole body strengthened, so from the blood of Christ, the same benefits are to be received by our souls through faith.

We have thought little of Your attributes and have been content in our spiritual understanding rather than seeking to know more of You. We have not hungered for Your word, but we have craved common things. Forgive us anew, we pray, and send Your Spirit so we may delight in Who You are and Your Holy Name.
