### **Unfinished Business**

- Mark Majdosz is setting dates for the "Special Needs" bucket drives. Signup sheets will be created and sent. Deacon Fowkes reports that the parish will meet the \$500 that the council has pledged, totaling \$1000 for the budget of the special needs CCD program. He also communicated to Fr. Twal in Jordan that we commit to \$10,000 over 5 years at \$2,000 per year. Checks for that can be written to OLMC parish Jordan fund.
- Legacy of Life baby bottle drive raised \$10,871, an increase of \$4,000 over previous year. This is attributed to the involvement of the Knights. Thanks to all who took part.
