- a. Review of the Comprehensive Land Use Plan

Review of the Comprehensive Plan continues with Commercial Land Use. As in previous sections of the Plan outline, anticipated land use is described by three categories – desired land uses, considered land uses and discouraged land uses.

Chairperson Steve Zahn asked that more investigation be done to determine the original location of the Lily Lake Cemetery. Dan Turner reports that possibly Margret Swanson has additional information concerning the location of the original cemetery. It is believed that the present location of the cemetery was selected for visibility to protect against attack at the time of a funeral.

Glenn Bork questioned the need to identify “discouraged land uses” within the proposed plan. Rather, the plan should remain positive noting that all proposed land uses are reviewed before approval.

Among future park/municipal land uses, Cheryl Pollak suggested a basketball court and fitness trail/interpretive center.
