 - A rep. From U.E.L. has been interviewed to outline the Loyalist Conference being held in Cornwall this year.
 - Cogeco will broadcast 5 episodes of 3 interviews each. The schedule will be decided shortly.
 - \$400 has been budgeted for public relations. Beside social media outlets, notices will also be put on the City page in Std Freeholder (K. Fernando) and Cornwall Local (G. Guy)
 - D. Ledoux advised Cornwall Square that the Fair will be held virtually due to the pandemic.

 - D. Ledoux reported no further progress. She will follow up with S. Jean who will have a plaque made for her house.
